### **From Denver International Airport (DIA) and I-70, and from I-25 southbound**

- Take Pena Boulevard South to **Interstate-70 (I-70) West**
- **From I-70 West**, exit from the right lane to **Interstate-25 South (I-25)** (towards Colorado Springs)
  - **From I-70 East**, exit from the right lane to **I-25 South**
- Proceed South, downtown Denver will be visible on your left.
- **From I-25**, take the 20th Street exit (Exit #212C)
- Make a left turn off the exit, to cross over the Interstate and proceed east
- Continue on 20th Street into Downtown Denver and make a right turn on Arapahoe Avenue (20th Street becomes a one way street in the opposing direction at Arapahoe Avenue)
- Make a quick left onto 19th Street
- Pass Curtis St. to Champa on which you can turn right, and proceed to 18th Street
- The EPA Conference Center in Denver Place takes up the entire city block between 18th and 19th, and Curtis and Champa.

### **From Interstate-25, Northbound**

- From I-25 North, take the Auraria Parkway exit (Highway 33)
- Once in Downtown Denver, and after crossing over Speer Boulevard, Auraria forks
- Veer left from Auraria onto Market Street
- Make a right onto 19th Street
- Go one block to Curtis or 2 blocks to Champa (on which you can turn right to 18th Street)
- The EPA Conference Center is in Denver Place takes up the entire block between 18th and 19th, and Curtis and Champa.

There are several commercial parking lots in the area. The underground parking garage entrance is on Curtis.
