REQUEST FOR DESIGNATION OF A THREE-JUDGE COURT

Plaintiff Steve Schonberg brings claims challenging the constitutionality of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, 2 U.S.C. §§ 431 et seq., and the Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act of 2002, Pub. L. No. 107-155, 116 Stat. 81. An action filed after December 31, 2006 that is "brought for declaratory or injunctive relief to challenge the constitutionality" of either of these acts "shall be filed in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia and shall be heard by a 3-judge court convened pursuant to [28 U.S.C. § 2284]" if the plaintiff requests a 3-judge court. Pub. L. No. 107-155, 116 Stat. 113-14. The plaintiff has filed an application for a 3-judge court. Accordingly, it is hereby requested that Chief Judge Sentelle designate two additional judges to participate in hearing and determining the plaintiff's claim. The Clerk is directed to transmit a copy of this request forthwith to the Clerk of the
