MATCHING FUND CERTIFICATIONS  
FOR PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES

WASHINGTON - JANUARY 15 - The Federal Election Commission today certified \$1,100,462.54 in federal primary matching funds for 6 Presidential candidates.

The candidates, and amounts certified today, are as follows:

Senator Lloyd M. Bentsen, Jr.:	18,992.77
James E. Carter:	53,936.99
President Gerald R. Ford:	118,485.20
Senator Henry M. Jackson:	806,585.78
Terry Sanford:	30,019.05
Congressman Morris K. Udall:	72,442.75

This raises to \$3,634,823.14 the total amount of primary matching funds certified this year by the FEC for 11 candidates.

Total matching funds including today's certifications, broken down by candidates are as follows:

Only "gifts of money" to a candidate up to \$250 per individual, are eligible for federal matching payments. Under Commission procedures, after a candidate has established "eligibility" for matching funds, the Commission will receive matching requests from the candidate on a twice-monthly basis, on the first and third Mondays of each month, and will certify eligible contributions within fifteen days after their submission.
