FEC HOLDS HEARINGS ON PROPOSED
REGULATIONS

WASHINGTON - MAY 26 - The Federal Election Commission will hold four days of public hearings on draft regulations under the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended in 1974, and 1976.

The proposed regulations, published for public comment today in Part II of the Federal Register, will be the subject of hearings according to the following schedule:

<u>Monday, June 7</u>	Parts 100-108: Disclosure
<u>Tuesday, June 8</u>	Part 112: Advisory Opinion Procedure Part 113: Office Accounts Parts 120-124: Convention Financing Parts 130-134: Presidential Primary Matching Fund
<u>Wednesday, June 9</u>	Part 109: Independent Expenditures Part 110: Contribution and Expenditure Limitations Part 111: Compliance Procedure
<u>Thursday, June 10</u>	Part 114: Corporation and Union Political Activity Part 115: Government Contractors

Hearings will be held from 9:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m., resuming at 2 p.m., in the 5th floor Conference Room of the FEC, 1325 K Street NW.

Following hearings and the receipt of written comment, the Commission will revise and then formally adopt the proposed regulations, and transmit them to Congress for review by the end of June.
