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FEC UPDATED SURVEY LISTS 14 PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES ON GENERAL ELECTION BALLOTS

WASHINGTON - OCTOBER 30 - The Federal Election Commission today released an updated survey of each state, and the District of Columbia, indicating that 14 candidates are on the November 2 general election ballots in various states as candidates for President.

The survey is current through information available through Friday, October 29. It is an update of a similar survey issued last week compiled through October 22.

The survey was compiled by the FEC's National Clearinghouse on Election Administration, and is based on information provided by each State and the District of Columbia.
