FEC CORRECTS NON-FILER LIST FOR PENNSYLVANIA 21st CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT

WASHINGTON - MAY 19 - The Federal Election Commission said today that it had erroneously cited two candidates from Pennsylvania's 21st Congressional District for failure to file required reports prior to Tuesday's Pennsylvania primary.

They are as follows:

- (1) The FEC had erroneously listed Robert H. Miller (Rep.) as having failed to file either the personal candidate or the campaign committee reports. Both reports had been received by Friday, May 12, and under FEC procedures, should not have been listed on the next day's non-filer list.
- (2) The FEC had erroneously cited <u>June Depietro (Dem)</u> for failing to file either the personal candidate or the campaign committee report. The personal candidate report had been received on Friday, May 12, and only the campaign committee should have been included on the next day's May 13 non-filer list.

Pre-election reports for the May 16 Pennsylvania primary were due on Saturday, May 6, 10 days prior to the election date. Under FEC procedures, a notice reminding candidates of the filing obligations is sent three weeks prior to the filing date. If a report is not received by the due date, two mailgrams are sent during the week before the election. Candidates and their campaign committees that still have not filed the required reports by Saturday noon before the election are publicly listed on the FEC non-filer publication.

The FEC also said that it had erroneously failed to include on its May 13 list the names of any Pennsylvania candidates who were unopposed on their party's primary ballot and who failed to file (or whose authorized committee failed to file) the required 10-Day pre-primary election Report.
