## REICHE TO BE SWORN IN AS NEW COMMISSIONER

WASHINGTON --- The Federal Election Commission will gain its newest member Tuesday morning when Frank P. Reiche is sworn in by Supreme Court Justice William R. Rehnquist.

The ceremony will take place at the Commission hearing room on the 5th floor of 1325 K St. NW at 9:45 a.m.

Reiche, who will be the tenth Commissioner since the FEC's founding in 1975, joins two fellow Republicans and three Democrats on the bi-partisan Commission.

Reiche, 50, has served for six years as Chairman of the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission. Prior to that, he was a member of the administration of Gov. William T. Cahill and was active in the Garden State GOP.
