WASHINGTON - Charles N. Steele has been appointed General Counsel of the Federal Election Commission. The appointment was announced today by FEC Chairman Robert O. Tiernan.

Mr. Steele, who has been with the Commission since January 1976, previously served as Associate General Counsel for Enforcement and Litigation.

Prior to his employment with the FEC, Mr. Steele was a staff attorney with the Appellate Court Branch of the National Labor Relations Board.
