WASHINGTON — Extension of opening hours this week has been announced by the Federal Election Commission for its Public Records Room. The action is taken to meet press and public interest in quarterly reports of Congressional campaign committees which are due on Tuesday, April 15, and of March monthly reports of Presidential candidates due Sunday, April 20.

Because of heightened interest in these reports, the Public Records Office will be open from 9 a.m. until 7 p.m., Tuesday, April 15, through Friday, April 18, and from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m., Saturday, April 19, and from 12 noon until 4 p.m., Sunday, April 20.

The FEC's Public Records Room makes copies of campaign finance reports available on microfilm and in paper copies, generally within 24 hours after a report is received. The facility is equipped with microfilm reader-printers, copy machines and other research tools. The Federal Election Commission is located at 1325 K Street, N.W., and the telephone number of the Public Records Office is 523-4181.
