FEC VOTES MORE MONEY FOR ANDERSON

WASHINGTON --- The Federal Election Commission today certified an additional \$77,397.76 to the general election National Unity Campaign for John Anderson.

Last November, based on unofficial results of the November 4th election showing Anderson had received 5,581,379 votes, the Commission voted to give Anderson \$4,164,906.24. This amount was \$42,069.76 shy of the total amount to which Anderson was entitled because the Commission decided to withhold 1% of the entitlement in the event official figures showed Anderson receiving less votes.

Official tabulations now show Anderson received 5,719,437 votes. This larger number entitles him to additional money, plus the amount originally withheld.

Anderson has now received a total of \$4,242,304 for his general election campaign. (Both major party candidates received \$29,440,000.) The \$4.2 million is all that the campaign will receive. It will be unknown until after the final audit of the campaign whether or not any of the funds must be repaid to the U.S. Treasury.
