WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission today released a supplemental report on the audit of the Dole for President Committee.

That report, issued in response to additional information filed by the Dole campaign, effectively reduces the amount of money the campaign must repay to the U.S. Treasury to \$3,369.44.

The original FEC audit report, released December 16, 1980, had required the campaign to repay \$51,182.67. Most of the repayment resulted from the committee's failure to provide information on expenditures it made with federal funds.

The Dole campaign was given 30 days from the release of the original audit report to submit additional information and/or to refute any of the Commission's audit findings.

The Commission considered all supplementary information filed by the campaign in reaching its final decision.

Repayment is required by March 26, 1981.
