## FEC APPOINTS KENTON TO NATIONAL PANEL

WASHINGTON--Mrs. Carolyn Kenton of Lexington, Kentucky, a member of the Kentucky State Legislature, has been appointed to membership on the Advisory Panel of the Federal Election Commission's National Clearinghouse on Election Administration.

FEC Chairman Danny Lee McDonald said that Representative Kenton's term will run from January 1, 1983, through December 31, 1984. "As a member of our Advisory Panel, Mrs. Kenton will help advise the Commission of the best ways to use its resources to help improve the administration of elections throughout the Nation", he said.

The 17 members of the Advisory Panel are selected by the FEC from among local and state elections administrators and public officials throughout the United States.

Mrs. Kenton will be taking part next month in a two-day meeting of the Advisory Panel in Washington, discussing problems encountered during the 1982 and preceding elections, application of computer technology to the election process, a Congressionally mandated FEC study on Voting Systems Standards and regional election administration seminars planned by the Federal Election Commission later this year.

Prior to her election to the State Legislature, Mrs. Kenton was head of the Reapportionment Clearinghouse for the Council on State Governments, and edited the election chapter of that organization's Book of the States.
