WASHINGTON -- A new "Campaign Guide for Nonconnected Political Committees" and a revised edition of regulations have just been published by the Federal Election Commission and are available to the public.

The new campaign guide is one of a series of publications covering specific areas of the Federal Election Campaign Act. Other guides cover Congressional Candidates and Committees, Political Party Committees and Corporations and Labor Organizations.

A nonconnected political committee is one that supports or opposes candidates for Federal office, but which is not established or administered by any candidate for federal office, any party committee or any corporation or labor organization.

The revised Federal Election Commission regulations include those approved earlier this year covering presidential primary activities. A printed supplement contains other new regulations including Presidential general election, which were approved by the FEC after publication deadline for the bound paperback volume.
