## FEC SENDS 1986 ANNUAL REPORT TO THE PRESIDENT, CONGRESS

WASHINGTON -- As it prepares for the 1988 elections, the Federal Election Commission has issued its twelfth Annual Report detailing the agency's role in the 1986 elections. Copies of the publication have been presented to the President, the President of the U.S. Senate and the Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives. The report is required by law to be delivered no later than June 1 each year.

Chapters one and two of the 1986 report examine the Commission's administration of federal election laws. The emphasis in chapter one is on Presidential elections. It reviews the public funding aspect of the 1984 election and discusses the agency's preparations for 1988. Campaign finance data is presented in chapter three, while the fourth chapter summarizes the FEC's internal operations. Chapter five focuses on possible legislative changes in election laws. Those recommendations were presented to Congress earlier this year.

A number of appendices appear in the 85 page report, covering a variety of data related to FEC activities.
