FEC APPOINTS LAWRENCE NOBLE AS GENERAL COUNSEL

The Federal Election Commission has appointed Lawrence M. Noble to be General Counsel of the Agency. He has been Acting General Counsel since the resignation of Charles Steele earlier this year.

Mr. Noble served as Deputy General Counsel to the FEC from November 1983, and prior to that he was Assistant General Counsel for Litigation and, earlier, a litigation attorney.

Before joining the FEC, he was an attorney with the Aviation Consumer Action Project.

A native of New York, he holds a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from Syracuse University and a Juris Doctor from the National Law Center at George Washington University.

Mr. Noble is a member of the U.S. Supreme Court Bar, the U.S. Court of Appeals Bar for the D.C. Circuit, the U.S. District Court Bar for the District of Columbia and the District of Columbia Bar. He is a member of the American and District of Columbia Bar Associations.
