FEC SEEKS COMMENTS ON PROPOSED RULEMAKING

WASHINGTON -- An "Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking" has been published by the Federal Election Commission, to examine generally the questions raised by the Supreme Court's opinion in the case involving the Massachusetts Citizens For Life, Inc.

The rulemaking will include, but not be limited to, the issue raised by the National Right to Work Committee in a "Petition For Rulemaking" filed with the FEC early last year.
