FEC SEEKS COMMENTS ON REGULATION PROPOSALS

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission is seeking public comments on two unrelated campaign finance regulations which have been proposed for redrafting.

The proposals, which were published in the Federal Register on June 7, 1989, under a "Second Notice of Proposed Rulemaking", concern changes in travel expense exemptions for campaign workers and prohibitions on foreign nationals.

Unlike its original publication on September 15, 1988, the current redrafting of the travel expense exemptions offers three alternative approaches to the regulations. This is the first publication for the proposal concerning foreign national regulations.
