FEC TO HOLD CAMPAIGN FINANCE SEMINAR IN WASHINGTON FOR FEDERAL CANDIDATES

WASHINGTON -- To assist U.S. House and Senate candidates prepare for the upcoming 1990 primary and general elections, the Federal Election Commission will host a one-day campaign finance conference at the Washington Court on Capitol Hill on March 30, 1990.

FEC Chairman Lee Ann Elliott, other Commissioners and staff members will conduct the workshops. Additionally, a representative of the Internal Revenue Service will speak on election-related tax issues.

Topics for the workshops, which are specifically designed for candidates (not political parties or PACs), include campaign operations, sources of support for candidates, reporting, new ethics rules, IRS requirements and FEC services.
