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FEC RELEASES REPORT ON HOME STATE VERSUS OUT-OF-STATE CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED BY 1990 U.S. SENATE CANDIDATES

WASHINGTON -- The following statistical report by the Federal Election Commission compares the amounts of itemized individual contributions by home state and out-of-state contributors to 1990, 1988 and 1986 U.S. Senate candidates.

A number of limitations of this narrowly focused report exist. Caution should be observed in any use of the information.

LIMITATIONS of this report include:

** Amounts of less than \$200 received from individuals are NOT included in the 1990 data and could significantly alter the actual percentages given by home state contributors versus out-of-state contributors. The 1990 chart details only individual contributions of more than \$200 which have been itemized in the FEC computer data base. During the 1988 and 1986 cycles only individual contributions of at least \$500 were itemized by the Commission.

** Only individual contribution amounts received during the specific election year are detailed. Activity for previous years leading up to an election is NOT listed and could also significantly alter the data.

** Contributions from political action committees are NOT included.

** Comparisons of the 1989-90 cycle data to the 1988 and 1986 cycles may NOT be valid due to incompatible contribution itemization thresholds (at least \$200 for '90 and at least \$500 for '88 and '86).

** A number of other factors could influence the data including the size and location of the state the candidate represents; the candidate's identification with specific issues which draw national attention; and the competitiveness of election races.

(NOTE: Federal election law requires that campaign committees must disclose and itemize information on all individual contributors who have given in excess of \$200 a year.)
