## NEBRASKA CAMPAIGN FAILS TO FILE PRE-PRIMARY REPORT

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission today cited the 1990 U.S. House campaign committee of Rod Johnson, a Republican from Nebraska's 3rd congressional district, with failure to file the required Pre-Primary financial disclosure report.\*

The disclosure report was due May 3, 1990, and would have detailed the campaign's financial activity from April 1 through April 25. If sent by certified or registered mail, the filing should have been postmarked by midnight, April 30.

On May 4, 1990, the Rod Johnson for Congress Committee, was notified by mailgram that the FEC had not received a 12-day pre-primary report. The campaign had four business days from the date of the mailgram to respond. Failure to file by close-of-business on May 10 resulted in this publication. Prior notification of the required filing was sent to the committee on April 9. Nebraska's primary will be conducted Tuesday, May 15.

Further Commission action against non-filers and late filers is decided on a case-by-case basis. Federal election law gives the FEC broad authority to initiate enforcement actions, including the imposition of civil penalties (\$5,000 for "any violation" and \$10,000 for any "knowing and willful" violation) for infractions of the law.

The next report due for Nebraska congressional candidates is the July Quarterly report due July 15.

\*The report was received May 11, after the statutory deadline for publication of non-filers.
