1992 SENATE CANDIDATE REFERENCE GUIDE AVAILABLE -Disclosure Reports Due by July 31-

WASHINGTON -- For reporters who are covering 1992 U.S. Senate campaigns, the Federal Election Commission has prepared a reference guide providing background on the financial activities of each current candidate through 1990.

This information is helpful in comparing financial activities, including the size of each candidate's war chest accumulated during the four year period prior to the upcoming 1992 race.

Information specifically available includes:

- Ranking based on size of war chests (cash-on-hand) of Senate candidates through 1990 cycle.
- Chart comparing cash-on-hand available at the end of the year preceding the election cycle for incumbents in 1986 race to the same seat in 1992.
- State-by-state chart detailing financial activities of each 1992 Senate candidate during the non-election 1988 and 1990 cycles. This chart includes information on receipts, disbursements, cash-on-hand and debts.

Senate and House candidates must file a mid-year disclosure report, which details campaign financial activity during the first six months of 1991. This disclosure must have a postmark of no later than July 31 if sent certified or registered mail - otherwise it is due on July 31.

House campaign disclosure reports are originally filed with the Clerk of the House, while Senate disclosure reports are filed with the Secretary of the Senate. Each report is then forwarded by the congressional offices to the FEC. PAC's and political parties file disclosure reports directly with the Commission.
