BOSTON TO BE SITE OF REGIONAL CAMPAIGN FINANCE CONFERENCE -Planning For '92 Federal & State Elections Underway-

WASHINGTON -- As the 1992 elections near, the Federal Election Commission will conduct a special two-day campaign finance conference in Boston on September 11 and 12.

This regional conference, which will be held at the Sheraton Boston Hotel & Towers, is designed to assist candidates, political parties and political action committees (PACs) prepare for upcoming primary and general election races.

FEC Chairman John Warren McGarry (a Boston native), Commissioners and staff will conduct numerous workshops on federal election rules and procedures, while a representative of the Internal Revenue Service will be available both days to answer election-related tax questions. Rules for state candidates and PACs is the topic for a specific workshop offered on September 12 by the Massachusetts Office of Campaign and Political Finance.

A guest luncheon speaker has not been announced.
