1992 PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES RAISE \$2.7 MILLION BY SEPTEMBER 30 -Overall financial activity far below '88 campaigns-

WASHINGTON -- Ten 1992 Presidential candidates raised \$2.7 million and spent \$1.5 million by the end of September, disclosure reports filed with the Federal Election Commission show.

During the same period of time in the 1988 'open seat' race for the White House, 17 campaigns reported receipts of \$70 million and disbursements of \$54.5 million.

Candidates who reported receiving contributions of at least \$40,000 from outside sources are detailed in the summary which includes eight Democrats, one Libertarian and one Independent. Although the incumbent, George Bush, has filed statements of candidacy and organization, his campaign reported no financial activity during the reporting period.

The chart attached to this release provides overall as well as specific data on receipts and disbursements for the candidates. Information in this campaign summary has been adjusted based on data in the disclosure reports. By subtracting all contribution refunds, loan repayments, and refunds or rebates received, these adjustments offer a more accurate financial view of campaign activity.

Because Presidential campaigns are filing disclosure reports quarterly in this non-election year, the next report will cover activity through December 31, and will be due January 31, 1992. Campaigns whose activity exceeds \$100,000 are required to file monthly reports in the year of the election.

The only additional activity to occur before the January disclosure reports are filed would be the FEC's certification of federal matching funds for qualified candidates. Public notices will be issued by the Commission each time a candidate is declared eligible or receives additional certification of matching fund requests. By law, campaigns will not begin receiving these public funds until January 1992. While the FEC certifies and audits campaigns that receive public funding, the U.S. Treasury Department is responsible for payment of the funds to candidates.
