

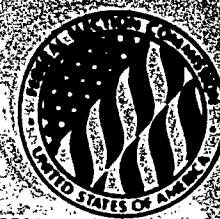

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REPUBLICAN PARTY SPENT \$123 MILLION MORE IN '90 THAN DEMOCRATS, FINAL FEC REPORT SHOWS

WASHINGTON -- Republican party committees raised \$121 million more and spent \$123 million more than Democratic party committees during the 1989-90 election cycle, according to the Federal Election Commission's Final Report on political party activity.

The Report, which confirmed previously released preliminary figures, found that all national and state Republican party committees raised \$206 million and spent \$213.5 million while Democratic committees raised \$85.7 million and spent \$90.8 million during the two-year period.

Democratic committees contributed \$1.4 million directly to federal candidates and spent \$8.7 million in coordinated expenditures. Contributions by Republican committees totalled \$2.9 million, while coordinated expenditures totalled \$10.7 million.

Despite ending cash-on-hand balances, both parties finished the cycle carrying debts: Republicans, \$7.6 million; Democrats, \$5.7 million. In contrast, both parties had cash surpluses at the end of the 1987-88 cycle.

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In terms of sources of funds, Republican committees received \$179.7 million, or 87 percent, from individuals and \$3.5 million, or 2 percent, from political action committees. Individual contributors gave \$56.3 million, or 66 percent, and PACs \$11.4 million, or 13 percent, to Democratic committees.

Attached to this release are various charts, graphs and tables describing overall political party financial activities during the cycle. One particular chart details party support, in terms of both contributions and coordinated expenditures, given to each general election candidate to the U.S. Senate and House. Another chart itemizes party support in terms of candidate type (ie incumbent, challenger or open seat). A pie graph depicts the sources of funds for both parties. Various charts show state party committee contributions to candidates of other states; national party committee transfers to state party committees; and joint fundraising activities.
