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1994 SENATE CAMPAIGNS UNDER WAY

WASHINGTON -- Candidates seeking election to the 34 Senate seats up for election in 1994 have reported raising almost \$25 million and spending \$7 million during the first six months of 1993. An additional \$11.5 million was raised and \$10.8 million spent by the two candidates involved in the special election held in Texas.

Although comparisons of Senate races are difficult because of their diversity, mid-year reports filed by this year's class of 50 candidates (excluding Texas) indicate less activity than the first six-month filings by candidates in either of the two previous election cycles. In the first half of 1989, 45 candidates reported raising \$29.3 million and spending \$9.6 million. Fifty-five Senate campaigns in 1991 raised \$33.3 million and spent \$10 million.

From January 1, through June 30, 1993, contributions from individuals accounted for \$17 million, or 69.2% of the total raised by Senate candidates. PAC money totalled \$6 million and represented 24.5% of receipts.

Candidates began the second half of the non-election year with \$29.3 million cash-on-hand. Reported debts of \$5.6 million related mostly to previous elections, with the largest debts - reported by Lautenberg of New Jersey and Kohl of Wisconsin - consisting of monies owed principally to the candidates themselves.

The attached pages provide summary statistical information on each candidate. Financial activity for 1989-90 and 1991-92 is also included, where available.

The next reports for Senate campaigns are due January 31, 1994, and will cover the last six months of 1993.
