PROPOSED CHANGES IN PERSONAL USE OF CAMPAIGN FUNDS REGULATIONS TO BE ADDRESSED AT JANUARY 12, 1994 PUBLIC HEARING

WASHINGTON -- A public hearing on proposed changes to the regulations on the personal use of campaign funds will be held by the Federal Election Commission on Wednesday, January 12, 1994. The hearing will start at 10 a.m. in the Commission's ninth floor hearing room.

The proposed changes would seek to define a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act, which prohibits the use of contributions for personal benefit, while also preserving the rights of candidates to determine the needs of their campaigns.
