MCDONALD ELECTED VICE CHAIRMAN OF FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION

WASHINGTON -- Danny Lee McDonald of Oklahoma has been elected Vice Chairman of the Federal Election Commission for 1994. The Commissioner twice previously has served as both Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Commission.

Prior to his initial appointment in 1981, the Sand Springs, Oklahoma native served as General Administrator of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission. Additionally, he served as Secretary of the Tulsa County Election Board and as Chief Clerk of that Board. Mr. McDonald was a member of the Advisory Panel to the FEC's National Clearinghouse on Election Administration. The Commissioner is currently a member of the Board of Trustees of the American Council of Young Political Leaders.

Mr. McDonald received a B.A. Degree from Oklahoma State University. He attended the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University and has served as a member of the JFK School Advisory Board for State and Local Government.

The Commissioner resides in Fort Washington, Maryland with his wife.
