FEC ANNOUNCES EXTENDED HOURS DURING FILING PERIOD

WASHINGTON -- The Public Records Office of the Federal Election Commission has scheduled weekend and extended hours to accommodate press and public who want to review quarterly disclosure reports filed by candidates, political action committees (PACs), and political party committees.

Campaign disclosure reports, which will cover financial activity through June 30, 1994, are due July 15, will be available for inspection and copying. The Public Records Office can be contacted at (202) 219-4140.

The extended hours are as follows:

If sent certified or registered mail, disclosure reports must be postmarked no later than midnight July 15. If sent by regular mail or hand-delivered, the reports are due by close of business on July 15. House and Senate campaigns file their reports with the Clerk of the House or Secretary of the Senate, respectively. Those offices then forward the reports to the FEC. Presidential, PAC, and party committees file their reports directly with the FEC.
