FEC ISSUES FINAL REPORT ON POLITICAL PARTY ACTIVITY FOR 1993-94

WASHINGTON -- Republican party committees raised \$111.1 million more and spent \$101.9 million more than Democratic party committees during the 1993-94 election cycle, according to the Federal Election Commission's Final Report on political party activity.

The Report, which confirmed previously released preliminary figures, found that all national and state Republican party committees raised \$254.4 million and spent \$243.7 million while Democratic committees raised \$143.3 million and spent \$141.8 million during the two-year period.

The following chart provides a comparison of political party activity during the past nine election cycles:

Democratic committees contributed \$2.2 million directly to federal candidates and spent \$21.2 million in coordinated expenditures.* Contributions by Republican committees totaled nearly \$3 million, while coordinated expenditures totaled \$20.6 million.

While both parties ended the cycle with cash surpluses, they also finished the period with debts. Republicans reported cash-on-hand of \$4.6 million and \$7.5 million in debts while Democrats reported cash-on-hand of \$3.8 million and \$10.5 million in debts.

Individuals contributed over \$218.5 million to the Republican party, and \$97.7 million to the Democratic party. The Report also shows that the \$12.8 million Democrats received from PACs was nearly 9% of their total receipts, while the \$4.8 million Republicans received from PACs was only 2% of their total receipts. This, however, represented a decline for Democrats of \$2.3 million from the 1992 cycle and a slight increase for Republicans of \$.3 million from the previous cycle.

Both major parties increased the amount of soft money they raised and spent over the previous cycle. Republicans raised \$59.5 million, up 15% from 1992, and spent \$55.5 million, up 11%, while Democrats raised \$46.9 million, up 27%, and spent \$47.8 million, 36% more than in 1992.

Republican non-federal accounts transferred \$8.4 million to state parties, contributed \$3.6 million to state and local candidates, and spent \$20.1 million on activities which had a joint federal and non-federal purpose. An additional \$23.3 million was spent for "other" expenses (i.e. building funds, etc.)

Democratic non-federal accounts transferred nearly \$11 million to state parties, contributed \$1.7 to state and local candidates, spent \$23.1 million in shared federal/non-federal activities, and nearly \$12 million on "other" expenses.

- National party committee transfers to state party committees for both federal and non-federal accounts.

[*Note: Coordinated expenditures are monies spent by national and state party committees on general election nominees and are in addition to contributions. Under the election law, these expenditures, like contributions, are limited in amount. Party committees may work with candidates' campaigns to determine how the monies should be spent, but the campaigns do not receive the funds. Expenditures are reported directly by the party committees on special schedules on their financial disclosure reports.]

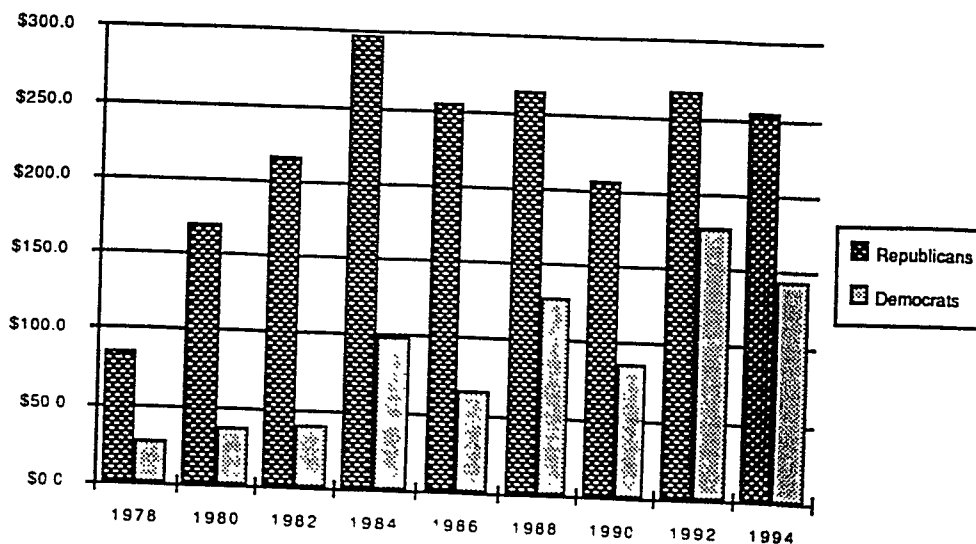

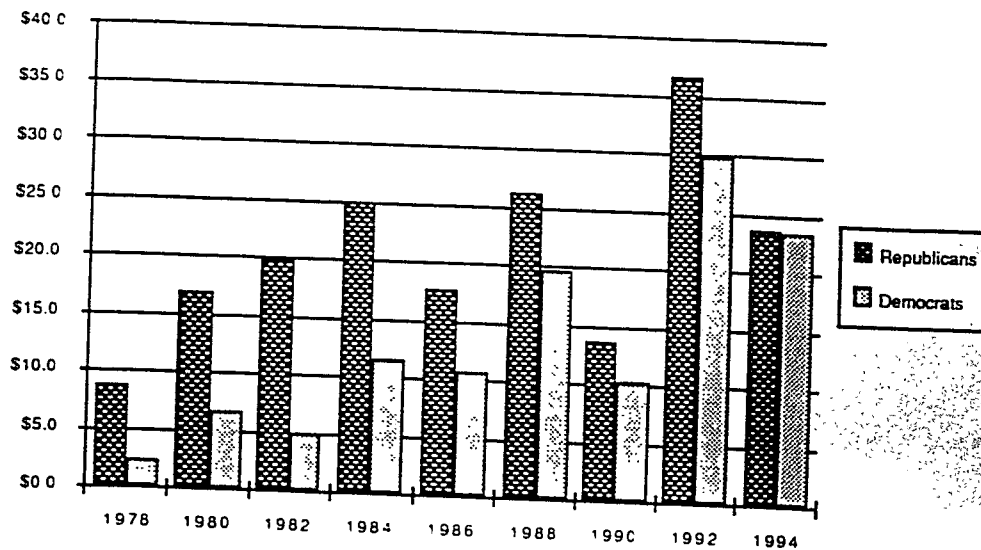

Federal Receipts of Major Party Committees 1978-1994

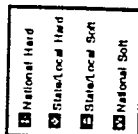
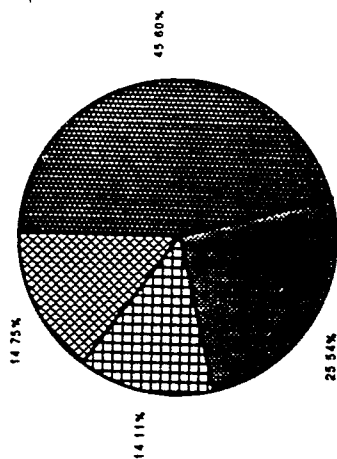


Party Support of Federal Candidates 1978-1994

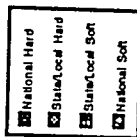
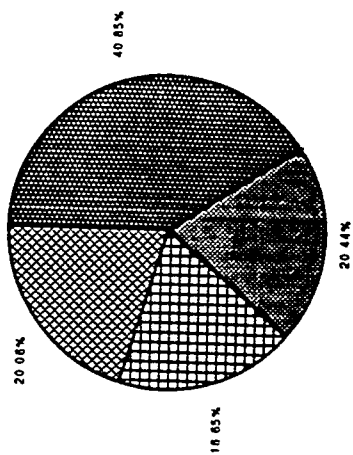

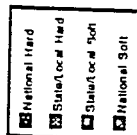
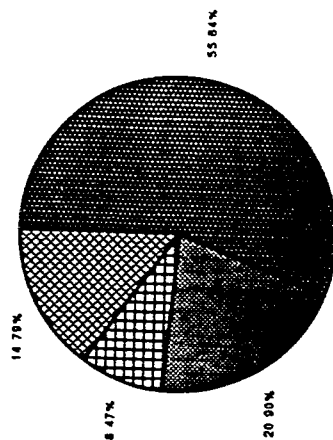
All Democratic Party Receipts Reported to the FEC - 1991-92 (\$250 million)



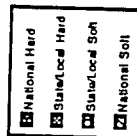
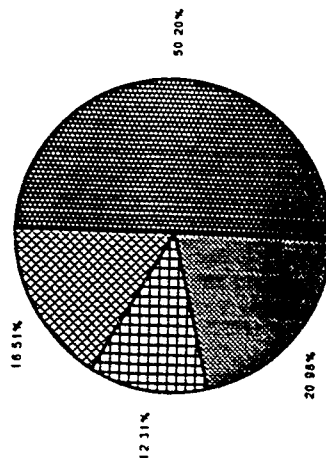
All Democratic Party Receipts Reported to the FEC - 1993-94 (\$321 million)



All Republican Party Receipts Reported to the FEC - 1991-92 (\$346 million)

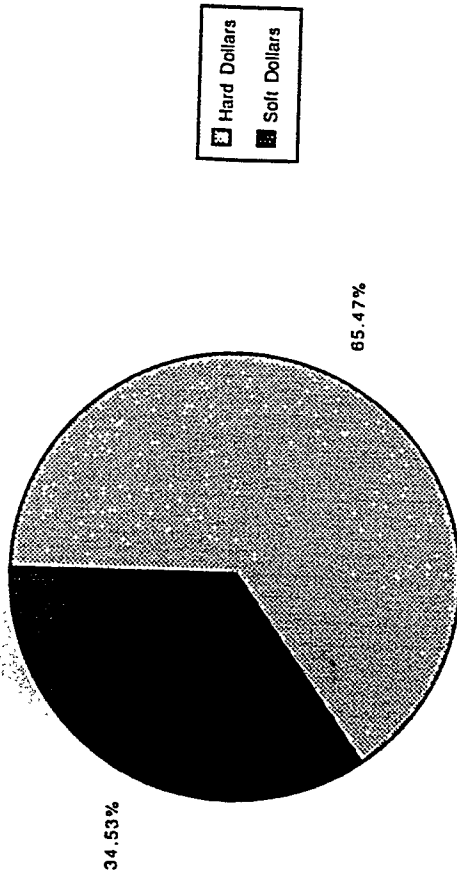


All Republican Party Receipts Reported to the FEC - 1993-94 (\$357 million)

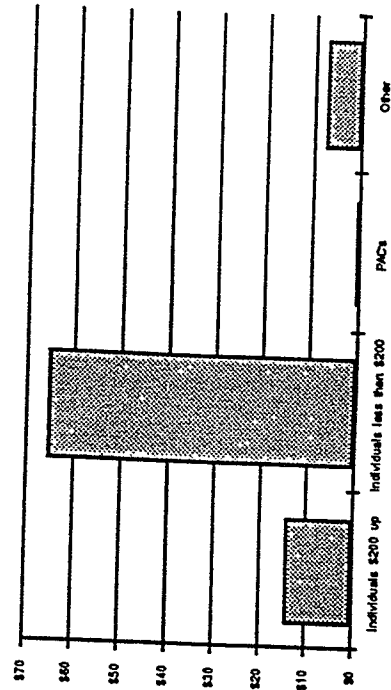

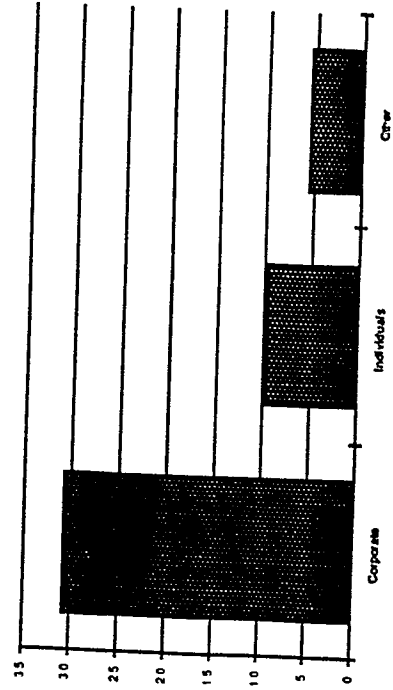
Total 1993-94 Fundraising - RNC (\$133.5 million)



Hard Dollar Receipts by Source 1993-94 RNC

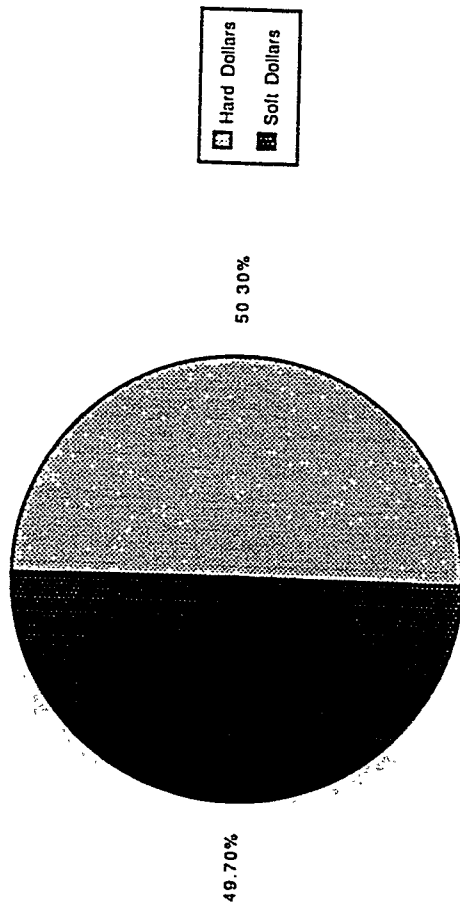


Soft Dollar Receipts by Source 1993-94 RNC

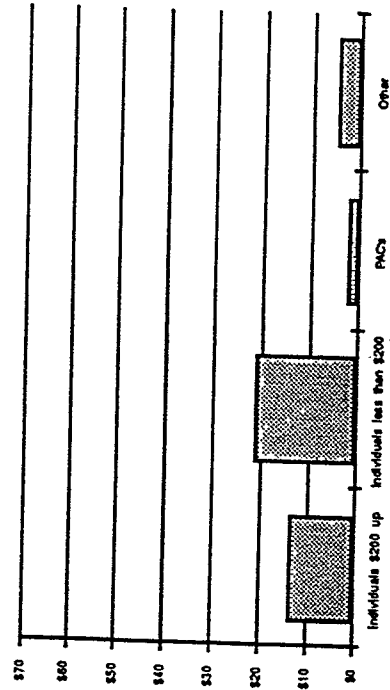

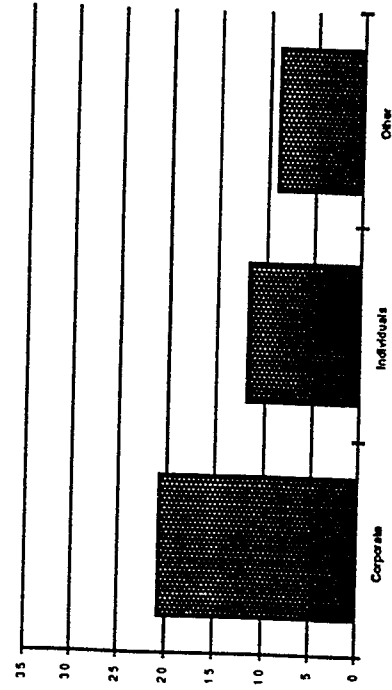
Total 1993-94 Fundraising - DNC (\$83.1 million)
