## FEC RELEASES FOUR COMPLIANCE CASES

WASHINGTON – The Federal Election Commission has made public its final action on four matters previously under review (MURs). This release contains only summary information. Closed files should be thoroughly read for details, including the FEC's legal analysis of the case. (Please see footnote at the end of this release.) Closed MUR files are available in the Public Records Office.

### 1. MUR 4194

**RESPONDENTS:** (a) Mascara for Congress, Edward Mendola, treasurer (PA)  
(b) Mascara Campaign Committee, Judith A. Cap, treasurer (PA)  
(c) Delores Mascara (PA)

**COMPLAINANTS:** FEC Initiated (RAD)

**SUBJECT:** Failure to file 48-hour reports; failure to accurately disclose terms of bank loan and lines of credit; excessive contributions; failure to register and report; failure to disclose disbursements

**DISPOSITION:** (a-b) Conciliation Agreement: \$50,000 civil penalty\*  
- Mascara for Congress Committee will disgorge \$12,250 in excessive contributions by returning such contributions to original contributors, and will amend their disclosure reports to reflect receipt of excessive contributions.  
- Mascara Campaign Committee will file all required disclosure reports reflecting the Committee's federal activity.  
(c) Reason to believe, but took no further action\*
