**SECOND CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO INSTITUTE
A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

Respondents Salazar for Congress and Les Williamson in his official capacity as treasurer, Freedom Force PAC and Les Williamson in his official capacity as treasurer, and Salazar Victory Committee and Les Williamson in his official capacity as treasurer (collectively, the “Committees”), hereby consent to toll the statute of limitations for any civil action, suit, or proceeding that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with Pre-MUR 652 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a) for an additional period of one hundred eighty (180) calendar days.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable to this matter. This Consent supplements the Consent previously agreed to by the Committees on March 1, 2022. There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Committees.
