



### **Continuing Legal Education (CLE) Credit**

The FEC has not applied in any state to be an official CLE sponsor. However, attendees have applied on their own and received continuing education credits for their attendance at FEC conferences. To receive CLE or other credit for any conference sponsored by the Federal Election Commission (FEC), you will need to do the following:

1. Contact your state bar and request information and any forms you may need to submit for accreditation for each FEC conference you will attend or have already attended.
2. Fill out the appropriate form and submit it to your state bar. Usually, you need to attach to the form a letter certifying your attendance (attached), along with a copy of the conference agenda, and speaker biographies, all of which are available on our [Virtual Conference materials page](#). Some states also require you to pay a fee.
3. Your state bar or MCLE organization will process your form and handle your credits for each conference.

Each state has different rules, so it is best that you contact your specific state bar association or MCLE administrative office to confirm your particular requirements.

### **Board of Accountancy Continuing Professional Education (CPE) Credit**

Most state boards of accountancy require that you submit a letter certifying your attendance (attached), along with a copy of the conference agenda, and speaker biographies, all of which are available on our [Virtual Conference materials page](#). However, each state's board of accountancy has different rules, so please contact your specific state's board of accountancy to confirm your particular requirements.
