Kent C. Cooper is Assistant Staff Director for Disclosure at the Federal Election Commission, which he joined at its establishment in 1975. He is responsible for the Commission's "storefront" public records office which provides public access to all campaign finance reports filed by Federal candidates and political committees, as well as other FEC public documents.

Prior to his service with the Commission, he was Director of the National Information Center on Political Finance, a non-profit research center. From 1972 to 1974 he was employed by the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives to handle the disclosure and review of reports filed after the passage of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971. Mr. Cooper served in U.S. Army Intelligence from 1969 to 1971 where he specialized in document control and security.

Mr. Cooper is a graduate of Georgetown University and presently resides with his wife and two children in Washington, D.C.

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
