Commissioners Broussard, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the decision.

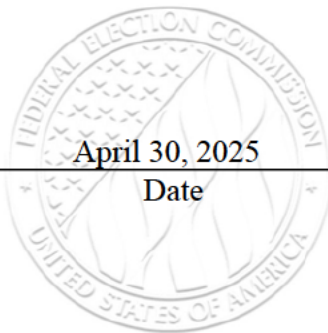
