SUBJECT: REASON TO BELIEVE RECOMMENDATION – WILLIE  
LANDRY MOUNT FOR CONGRESS - FAILURE TO FILE 48-  
HOUR NOTICES UNDER THE ADMINISTRATIVE FINE  
PROGRAM

Attached is the name of a principal campaign committee that has failed to file 48-hour notices with the Commission for contributions of \$1,000 or more received from the close of books for the Louisiana 12 Day Pre-Runoff Report up to 48 hours before the December 4, 2004 Runoff Election in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 434(a)(6) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(f). The Willie Landry Mount for Congress committee represents a candidate who lost the Runoff Election and failed to file 48-hour notices for contributions totaling \$76,650.00.

On July 1, 2004, Prior Notice was sent to the committee which included a section detailing the requirements for the filing of 48-hour notices for those committees involved in both the General and Runoff Elections. The section read as follows:

**“Notices are required if the committee receives contributions (including in-kind gifts or advances of goods or services; loans from the candidate or other non-bank sources; and guarantees or endorsements of loans to the candidate or committee) of \$1,000 or more, during the period of November 15 through December 1, 2004. The notices must reach the appropriate federal and state filing offices within 48 hours of the committee’s receipt of the contribution(s).”**

A 48-hour notice is required to report all contributions of a \$1,000.00 or more, to any authorized committee of a candidate, including contributions from the candidate,

loans from the candidate and other non-bank sources and endorsements or guarantees of loans from banks, as per, 11 C.F.R § 104.5(f).

We have attached an information sheet which includes the name, date of receipt and amount of the contribution for which a 48-hour notice was not filed.

In accordance with the schedule of civil money penalties outlined within 11 C.F.R §111.44, this committee should be assessed the civil money penalty so indicated.

#### Recommendation

1. Find reason to believe that Willie Landry Mount for Congress and Lester Langley Jr., Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. 434(a)(6) and make a preliminary determination that a civil money penalty of \$8765.00 be assessed.
2. Send the appropriate mailgram.

THE FEDERAL ELECTION CAMPAIGN ACT OF 1971, AS AMENDED ("THE ACT"), REQUIRES PRINCIPAL CAMPAIGN COMMITTEES OF CANDIDATES FOR FEDERAL OFFICE TO NOTIFY IN WRITING EITHER THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE OR THE FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION ("FEC"), AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE, AS APPROPRIATE, OF ANY CONTRIBUTION OF \$1,000 OR MORE, RECEIVED BY ANY AUTHORIZED COMMITTEE OF THE CANDIDATE AFTER THE 20TH DAY, BUT MORE THAN 48 HOURS BEFORE, ANY ELECTION. THE ACT FURTHER REQUIRES NOTIFICATION TO BE MADE WITHIN 48 HOURS AFTER THE RECEIPT OF THE CONTRIBUTION AND TO INCLUDE THE NAME OF THE CANDIDATE AND OFFICE SOUGHT, THE DATE OF RECEIPT, THE AMOUNT OF THE CONTRIBUTION, AND THE IDENTIFICATION OF THE CONTRIBUTOR. THE NOTIFICATION OF THESE CONTRIBUTIONS SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. 2 U.S.C. 434(A). YOU WERE PREVIOUSLY NOTIFIED OF THE REQUIREMENT TO FILE THESE NOTICES. RECORDS AT THE FEC INDICATE THAT YOU DID NOT SUBMIT 48-HOUR NOTICES FOR CONTRIBUTIONS OF \$1,000 OR MORE, RECEIVED BETWEEN 11/15/2004 AND 12/01/2004, TOTALING \$76,650.

THE ACT WAS FURTHER AMENDED IN 1999 TO PERMIT THE FEC TO IMPOSE CIVIL MONEY PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF 2 U.S.C. 434(A). 2 U.S.C. 437G(A)(4). BASED ON THE FEC'S SCHEDULE OF CIVIL MONEY PENALTIES AT 11 C.F.R. 111.44, THE AMOUNT OF YOUR CIVIL MONEY PENALTY CALCULATED AT THE RTB STAGE IS \$8,765. SEND YOUR PAYMENT BY 08/06/2005. THE AMOUNT OF THE CIVIL MONEY PENALTY IS \$100 FOR EACH NON-FILED NOTICE PLUS 10 PERCENT OF THE DOLLAR AMOUNT

YOUR RESPONSE MUST BE RECEIVED BY 08/06/2005. YOUR WRITTEN RESPONSE MUST INCLUDE THE REASON(S) WHY YOU ARE CHALLENGING THE RTB FINDING AND/OR CALCULATED CIVIL MONEY PENALTY. THE FEC WILL ONLY CONSIDER CHALLENGES THAT ARE BASED ON A FACTUAL ERROR, MISCALCULATION OF THE CALCULATED CIVIL MONEY PENALTY BY THE FEC, OR THE EXISTENCE OF EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES THAT PERSISTED FOR MORE THAN 48 HOURS THAT WERE BEYOND YOUR CONTROL AND PREVENTED YOU FROM FILING THE 48-HOUR NOTICE(S) IN A TIMELY MANNER. YOUR RESPONSE MUST INCLUDE THE FACTUAL BASIS SUPPORTING THE REASON(S) AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION. THE FEC STRONGLY ENCOURAGES THAT DOCUMENTS BE SUBMITTED IN THE FORM OF AFFIDAVITS OR DECLARATIONS. EXAMPLES OF CIRCUMSTANCES THAT WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED EXTRAORDINARY INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, NEGLIGENCE, PROBLEMS WITH VENDORS OR CONTRACTORS, STAFF ILLNESS, COMPUTER FAILURES AND SIMILAR CIRCUMSTANCES. 11 C.F.R. 111.35(B)(1)(III) AND (4).

The above-referenced Congressional Campaign requests a waiver of penalties for filing incorrect 48-hour reports for the above-referenced period. This request is made based on reasonable cause. Prior to October 7, 2004, I was preparing the reports for the above-referenced campaign. After that date, Ryan Hawkins and Amy Sanchez, with the Democrats for Congress Campaign Committee (DCCC) came to Louisiana and took over the financial reporting during the run-off. On October 7, 2004, the DCCC requested a copy our data files from our reporting system (FEC). They converted the files to their own reporting system (NGP).

The NGP system duplicated the contributions that were previously reported on a 48-hour report and also reported on the regular report. For example: If a contribution was included in a 48-hour report it would show up as two contributions of \$1,000 - one for the 48-hour report and one for the regular report.

After the run-off of the election, all of the data was returned to us. During this period, no bank reconciliations were completed by the DCCC, therefore the "cash-on-hand" on the reports and the actual "cash-on-hand in bank" did not reconcile. The majority of the deposits did not have copies of the checks attached.

All of the errors, which have created the penalties of \$8,765 occurred during the period that the DCCC was completing reports for the campaign. The errors in the 48-hour report were not due to negligence or willful failure to follow the rules and regulations of the FEC. Unfortunately, because of the information being held by the DCCC during the run-off period, we were unable to



AF# 1409 – Willie Landry Mount for Congress and Lester Langley, Jr., as Treasurer (C00395558)

On June 27, 2005, the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") found reason to believe ("RTB") that Willie Landry Mount for Congress and Lester Langley, Jr., as Treasurer ("the respondents"), violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file 48-Hour Notices for 43 contributions of \$1,000 or more received between November 15 and December 1, 2004, totaling \$76,650. On that same date, the Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$8,765 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.44. The respondents were notified by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") via mailgram on June 29, 2005 of the Commission's finding and civil money penalty calculated at RTB.

**Respondents' Response**

On August 8, 2005, the Commission received the written response ("challenge") from the Treasurer, challenging the RTB civil money penalty "based on reasonable cause." He states that "prior to October 7, 2004, I was preparing the reports," and "[a]fter that date, Ryan Hawkins and Amy Sanchez, with the Democrats for Congress Campaign Committee (DCCC) ... took over the financial reporting during the run-off." He explains that on

October 7, 2004, the DCCC requested a copy [of] our data files from our reporting system (FEC). They converted the files to their own reporting system (NGP).

The NGP system duplicated the contributions that were previously reported on a 48-hour report and also reported on the regular report. For example: If a contribution was included in a 48-hour report it would show up as two contributions of \$1,000 – one for the 48-hour report and one for the regular report.

After the run-off of the election, all of the data was returned to us. During this period, no bank reconciliations were completed by the DCCC, therefore "cash-on-hand" on the reports and the actual "cash-on-hand in bank" did not reconcile. The majority of the deposits did not have copies of the checks attached.

The Treasurer states that all of the "errors ... occurred during the period that the DCCC was completing reports for the campaign" and "were not due to negligence or willful failure to follow the rules and regulations of the FEC." He explains that "because of the information being held by the DCCC during the run-off period, we were unable to verify the accuracy of the 48-hour reports" and "request ... that [the Commission] waive the penalties."

**Telephone Records Provided with RAD Declaration**

In her declaration for AF# 1409, the Compliance Branch Chief states that she has provided "all relevant telecoms" [written records of telephone conversations] for conversations

on January 10, February 15 and 24, May 5, and June 16, 2005 between Committee representatives and RAD Analyst, Sally Bacon. In her January 10 telecom, Ms. Bacon states that Ms. Ryan called and said that "the Committee was in the process of filing amendments for multiple reports ... would be adding contributions that it had inadvertently missed," and "informed me that some of the additional contributions would not have 48-Hour notices filed for them."

On February 15, Ms. Bacon states that "Ms. Kaplan called with questions regarding the 30 Day Post-Runoff report" and "that the DCCC came in and 'meddled with things.'" Ms. Bacon told her "to check her election cycle dates to produce the Post Election Detailed Summary page" but that "nothing ... could be done regarding the missing 48-Hour notices since they are time sensitive."

In her February 24 telecom, Ms. Bacon states that Ms. Kaplan called "regarding the 48-Hour notice discrepancies that prompted the committee to be cited for failing to file 48-Hour notices. She explained that there were some discrepancies due to data entry errors on the report" and "cited the following:

Ms. Bacon advised her to "explain these discrepancies in a memo text on the amendment" to the report.

The remaining conversations between Ms. Kaplan and Ms. Bacon on May 5 and June 16 concerned the process for terminating the Committee and the Committee's "increased missing 48-Hour notices" referenced in RAD's May 19, 2005 letter.

### Analysis of Challenge

Based on a review of the Commission's records, there is no indication that 48-Hour Notices were filed for 43 contributions totaling \$76,650 which were received during the period of November 15 through December 1, 2004.

The Federal Election Campaign Act ("Act") requires that the principal campaign committee of a candidate must notify the Commission, in writing, of any contribution of \$1,000 or more received after the 20<sup>th</sup> day but more than 48 hours before the December 4 Run-off Election. The principal campaign committee must notify the Commission within 48 hours of receipt of the contribution. The 48-hour notification shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements under the Act. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(f). The treasurer shall be personally responsible for the timely filing of reports. 11 C.F.R. § 104.14(d).

Prior Notice for the Louisiana Pre- and Post-Runoff Reports, which was sent on July 1, 2004, states that 48-Hour Notices are required if the committee receives contributions of \$1,000 or more during the period of November 15 through December 1. The Notice informs committees and their treasurers that the 48-Hour Notices must reach the appropriate federal filing office within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s) and, if they fail to file 48-Hour Notices on time, they may be subject to civil money penalties. Included with the Prior Notice is the "Administrative Fine Program" handout which explains how the program works, which

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reports are covered, how the civil money penalties are calculated, and provides examples of civil money penalty calculations. The Prior Notice was sent to the respondents at their address of record.

According to the respondents, the Treasurer filed reports for the Committee up until October 7, at which time the DCCC "took over the financial reporting during the run-off" and converted the Committee's data to their own reporting system. The data responsibility for filing reports was returned to the respondents after the run-off; however, no bank reconciliations took place while the data was in possession of the DCCC, and the fine is subsequently a result of the filing of incorrect 48-hour reports and errors that occurred while the DCCC completed the Committee's reports.

Although someone other than the Treasurer, in this case, the DCCC staff, may have "complet[ed] reports for the campaign" during the period in which the 48-Hour Notices were required of the Committee, it is still the Treasurer's responsibility under the Act to file reports in a timely manner.

The respondents also point out that the failure to file 48-Hour Notices for these contributions was "not due to negligence." The administrative fine regulations are clear that negligence does not constitute "extraordinary circumstances" as defined at 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b).

The other issue raised in the challenge (that the errors were "not due to ... willful failure to follow the rules and regulations of the FEC") does not fall within the list of defenses outlined in 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b). The respondents' challenge presented no evidence that a factual error was made, that the civil money penalty was miscalculated at RTB or that extraordinary circumstances existed which prevented them from filing 48-Hour Notices for \$76,650 in contributions of \$1,000 or more received during the period of November 15 through December 1, 2004. The Reviewing Officer, therefore, recommends that the Commission make a final determination that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$8,765.

#### **OAR Recommendations**

- (1) Make a final determination in AF# 1409 that Willie Landry Mount for Congress and Lester Langley, Jr., as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$8,765; and
- (2) Send the appropriate letter.



RECORDS AT THE FEC INDICATE THAT YOU DID NOT SUBMIT 48-HOUR NOTICES FOR CONTRIBUTIONS OF \$1,000 OR MORE, RECEIVED BETWEEN 11/15/2004 AND 12/01/2004, TOTALING \$76,650.

THE AMOUNT OF THE CIVIL MONEY PENALTY IS \$100 FOR EACH NON-FILED NOTICE PLUS 10 PERCENT OF THE DOLLAR AMOUNT



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## DECLARATION OF DAYNA C. BROWN

1. I am the Reviewing Analyst in the Office of Administrative Review for the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"). In my capacity as Reviewing Analyst, I conduct research with respect to all challenges submitted in accordance with the Administrative Fine program.
2. The principal campaign committee of a congressional candidate must file notifications disclosing contributions of \$1,000 or more which are received between November 15 and December 1, 2004. These notifications (also called 48-Hour Notices) must be filed with the Commission within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s).
3. It is the practice of the Commission's Information Division to send prior notification of a report's due date to committees and treasurers at their address of record approximately three weeks before the report's due date and to include the "Administrative Fine Program" handout with each prior notification.
4. I hereby certify that I have searched the Commission's public records and that the documents identified herein are true and accurate copies of:
  - a) Request for Additional Information dated February 4, 2005 which is addressed to Willie Landry Mount for Congress and Lester Langley, Jr., as Treasurer. According to the Commission's records, the Request was sent by the Reports Analysis Division and references the 30 Day Post-Runoff Report. On Page 5 of the Request, it states that "Schedule A ... indicates that your committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48 hour notices regarding 'last minute' contributions received by your committee after the close of books for the 12 Day Pre-Runoff report (see attached). A principal campaign committee must notify the Commission, in writing, within 48 hours of any contribution of \$1,000 or more received between two and twenty days before an election."
  - b) Page 1 of the Summary Page, 37 pages of Schedule A, and electronic text for the amended 2004 30 Day Post Run-off Report electronically filed by Willie Landry Mount for Congress and Lester Langley, Jr., as Treasurer. According to the Commission's records, the report covers the period from November 15 through December 24, 2004, and was received on February 24, 2005. Schedule A lists the receipt of 43 contributions totaling \$76,650 on November 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30, and December 1, 2004. Each contribution equals \$1,000 or more; and
  - c) Request for Additional Information dated May 19, 2005 which is addressed to Willie Landry Mount for Congress and Lester Langley, Jr., as Treasurer. According to the Commission's records, the Request was sent by the Reports Analysis Division and references the Amended 30 Day Post-Runoff Report. On Page 1 of the Request, it states that "Schedule A ... indicates that your committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48 hour notices regarding 'last minute' contributions received by your committee after the close of books for the 12 Day Pre-Runoff Report (see attached.) A principal campaign committee must notify the Commission, in writing, within 48 hours of any contribution of \$1,000 or more received between two and twenty days before an election."

5. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct and that this declaration was executed at Washington on the 30<sup>th</sup> of October, 2006.

-Your committee failed to file a Post-Election Detailed Summary Page. The Post-Election Detailed Summary Page must be used in lieu of the Detailed Summary Page and Line Numbers 6-7 of the Summary Page for the first report filed after completion of the election cycle. The Post-Election Detailed Summary Page can be downloaded from the FEC web site ([www.fec.gov](http://www.fec.gov)). Please amend your report to include a Post-Election Detailed Summary Page. (11 CFR §§ 104.2(a) and 104.3)

-Schedule A of your report discloses one or more contributions that appear to exceed the limits set forth in the Act (see attached). You should examine all of your contributions to check for additional excessive contributions. The Committee's procedures for processing contributions should also be reviewed.

An individual or a political committee other than an authorized committee or qualified multi-candidate committee may not make a contribution to a candidate for federal office in excess of \$2,000 per election. on contributions made with respect to that election, or (2) your committee redesignates by presumption the excessive portion of the contribution for another election provided that the new designation does not exceed the limitations on contributions made with respect to that election. In this case, the treasurer must notify the contributor of the redesignation in writing within 60 days of the treasurer's receipt of the contribution. The notification must give the contributor an opportunity to request a refund. (11 CFR §110.1(b)(5)(i)(B)) Please note that you cannot presumptively redesignate an excessive contribution from a multi-candidate committee. Also, a contribution can only be redesignated to a previous election to the extent that the contribution does not exceed the committee's net debts outstanding for that election. (11 CFR §110.1(b)(3)(i))

If the foregoing conditions for reattributions or redesignations are not met within 60 days of receipt of the contribution, the excessive amount must be refunded. See 11 CFR §103.3(b)(1).

The funds can be retained if within sixty (60) days of receipt the excessive amount was properly redesignated for a different election. An excessive contribution is considered properly redesignated if (1) the committee obtains signed written documentation from the contributor(s) authorizing the redesignation of the contribution for another election provided that the new designation does not exceed the limitations on contributions made with respect to that election, or (2) the committee redesignates by presumption the excessive portion of the contribution for another election provided that the new designation does not exceed the limitations on contributions made with respect to that election. In this case, the treasurer must notify the

contributor of the redesignation in writing within 60 days of the treasurer's receipt of the contribution. The notification must give the contributor an opportunity to request a refund. (11 CFR §110.1(b)(5)(ii)(B))





On June 27, 2005, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") found reason to believe ("RTB") that Willie Landry Mount for Congress and you, as Treasurer ("respondents"), violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file 48-Hour Notices for 43 contributions of \$1,000 or more received between November 15 and December 1, 2004. The Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$8,765 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.44.

After reviewing your written response and any supplemental information submitted by you and Commission staff, the Reviewing Officer has recommended that the Commission make a final determination in this matter. A copy of the Reviewing Officer's recommendation is attached.

You may file with the Commission Secretary a written response to the recommendation within 10 days of the date of this letter. Your written response should be sent to the Commission Secretary, 999 E Street, NW, Washington, DC 20463. This letter is in response to your letter dated October 31, 2006 concerning the recommendation to our challenge for the penalty for failing to file 48-Hour Notices.

The \$8,765 fine imposed is a result of the filing of incorrect 48-hour reports and errors that occurred while the DCCC completed the Committee's reports. The treasurer did not have access to the contribution and expenditure information to verify the accuracy of the reports that the DCCC filed. The treasurer was not able to reconcile the bank account until after the run-off. The copies of contributor checks and bank deposits were missing from the financial data that was returned by DCCC.

The Democrats for Congress Campaign Committee insisted on taking over the financial reporting during the run-off. They requested a copy of our data and transferred it to their NGP program. When the financial data was returned to us, it could not be converted back to our system. Therefore, we had to purchase the NGP program to complete the filings. There is a \$50.00 per month user fee for maintaining the NGP program, which the campaign committee has paid since October, 2005.

According to Sally Bacon, RAD Analyst, it was not possible to amend 48-Hour reports, due to their nature. When we explained the reason for the late filings she agreed and understood that this was not the first time that a national committee had done this.



On June 27, 2005, the Federal Election Commission (“the Commission”) found reason to believe (“RTB”) that Willie Landry Mount for Congress and Lester Langley, Jr., as Treasurer (“the respondents”), violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file 48-Hour Notices for 43 contributions of \$1,000 or more received between November 15 and December 1, 2004. As a result, on June 27, 2005, the Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$8,765 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.44.

On August 8, 2005, the Commission received the respondents’ written response (“challenge”). After reviewing the challenge, the Reviewing Officer’s recommendation dated October 30, 2006 was forwarded to the Commission. A copy was simultaneously forwarded to the respondents. The Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission make a final determination that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$8,765 because the respondents submitted no evidence that a factual error was made, that the civil money penalty was miscalculated, at RTB or that extraordinary circumstances existed which prevented them from filing the 48-Hour Notices.

Within 10 days of transmittal of the recommendation, the respondents may file a written response with the Commission Secretary which may not raise any arguments not raised in the respondents’ challenge or not directly responsive to the Reviewing Officer’s recommendation. 11 C.F.R. § 111.36(f). The written response was received via facsimile from the Treasurer on November 6, 2006, and is attached for your review.

Dear Mr. Langley:

On June 27, 2005, the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") found reason to believe ("RTB") that Willie Landry Mount for Congress and you, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file 48-Hour Notices for 43 contributions of \$1,000 or more received between November 15 and December 1, 2004. By mailgram dated June 29, 2005, the Commission sent you notification of the RTB finding that included a civil money penalty calculated at RTB of \$8,765 in accordance with the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.44. On August 8, 2005, the Office of Administrative Review received your written response challenging the RTB civil money penalty.

The Reviewing Officer reviewed the Commission's RTB finding with its supporting documentation and the challenge. Based on this review, the Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission make a final determination that Willie Landry Mount for Congress and you, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty in the amount of \$8,765 in accordance with 11 C.F.R. § 111.44. The basis for the Reviewing Officer's recommendation was included in the Final Determination Report, a copy of which was sent to you on October 31, 2006. The Commission Secretary received your written response on November 6, and a copy was forwarded to the Commission.

On November 17, 2006, the Commission adopted the Reviewing Officer's recommendation and made a final determination that Willie Landry Mount for Congress and you, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assessed a civil money penalty of \$8,765. It is based on the same factors used to calculate the civil money penalty at RTB.

**To Pay the Civil Money Penalty**

To pay the civil money penalty, send the enclosed form and your payment to the address on page 3 within 30 days of receipt of this letter.

**If You Do Not Pay the Civil Money Penalty**

Unpaid civil money penalties assessed through the Administrative Fine regulations will be subject to the Debt Collection Act of 1982 ("DCA") as amended by the Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996 ("DCIA"), 31 U.S.C. § 3701 et seq. If you do not pay this debt within 30 days (or file a written petition to a federal district court - see below), the Commission will transfer the debt to the U.S. Department of the Treasury ("Treasury") for collection. Within 5 days of the transfer to Treasury, Treasury will contact the debtor and request payment. Treasury currently charges a fee of 28% of the civil money penalty amount for its collection services. The fee will be added to the amount of the civil money penalty that you owe. Should Treasury's attempts fail, Treasury will refer the debt to a private collection agency ("PCA"). If the debt remains unpaid, Treasury may recommend that the Commission refer the matter to the Department of Justice for litigation.


**If You Choose to Appeal the Final Determination and/or Civil Money Penalty**

If you choose to appeal the final determination, you should submit a written petition, within 30 days of receipt of this letter, to the district court of the United States for the district in which the committee or you reside, or transact business, requesting that the final determination be modified or set aside. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(C)(iii). Your failure to raise an argument in a timely fashion during the administrative process shall be deemed a waiver of the respondents' right to present such argument in a petition to the district court under 2 U.S.C. § 437g. 11 C.F.R. § 111.38.

The confidentiality provisions at 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12) no longer apply and this matter is now public. The file will be made a part of the public record pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 111.42(b). Although the file must be placed on the public record within 30 days from the date of the Commission's notification, this could occur at any time following certification of the Commission's vote.
