The committee listed on the attached RTB Circulation Report filed the report eight (8) days after the due date. In accordance with the schedule of civil money penalties located within 11 CFR §111.43, the committee should be assessed the civil money penalty included on the attached report.

THE FEDERAL ELECTION CAMPAIGN ACT OF 1971, AS AMENDED ("THE ACT"), REQUIRES THAT YOUR COMMITTEE FILE A SEPTEMBER MONTHLY REPORT OF RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS COVERING THE PERIOD THROUGH AUGUST 31ST. ON 10/27/2005, THE FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION ("FEC") FOUND REASON TO BELIEVE ("RTB") THAT TENNESSEE DEMOCRATIC PARTY AND YOU, AS TREASURER, VIOLATED 2 U.S.C. 434(A) FOR FAILING TO TIMELY FILE THE 2005 SEPTEMBER MONTHLY REPORT. BY MAILGRAM DATED 10/28/2005, THE FEC SENT YOU NOTIFICATION OF THE RTB FINDING THAT INCLUDED A CIVIL MONEY PENALTY CALCULATED AT THE RTB STAGE OF \$1600 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE OF PENALTIES AT 11 C.F.R. 111.43. WITHIN 40 DAYS OF THE FEC'S RTB FINDING, YOU WERE REQUIRED TO EITHER TRANSMIT PAYMENT OF THE CALCULATED CIVIL MONEY PENALTY OR SUBMIT A WRITTEN RESPONSE CHALLENGING EITHER THE RTB FINDING OR THE CALCULATED CIVIL MONEY PENALTY.
