SUBJECT: REASON TO BELIEVE RECOMMENDATION -
FAILURE TO FILE 48-HOUR NOTICES UNDER THE
ADMINISTRATIVE FINE PROGRAM

Attached is the name of a principal campaign committee that has failed to file 48-hour notices with the Commission for contributions of \$1,000.00 or more received from the close of books for the 12 Day Pre-General Election Report up to 48 hours before the November 7, 2006 General Election in accordance with 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(f). John Hall for Congress represents a candidate who won the General Election in the state of New York. The committee failed to file 48-hour notices for contributions totaling \$44,261.08.

On October 2, 2006, Prior Notice was sent to the committee which included a section detailing the requirements for filing 48-hour notices. The section read as follows:

“Notices are required if the committee receives contributions (including in-kind gifts or advances of goods or services; loans from the candidate or other non-bank sources; and guarantees or endorsements of loans to the candidate or committee) of \$1,000.00 or more, during the period of October 19 through November 4, 2006. The notices must reach the appropriate federal and state filing offices within 48 hours of the committee’s receipt of the contribution(s).”

A 48-hour notice is required to report all contributions of a \$1,000.00 or more, to any authorized committee of a candidate, including contributions from the candidate, loans from the candidate and other non-bank sources and endorsements or guarantees of loans from banks, as per, 11 C.F.R § 104.5(f).

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We have attached an information sheet which includes the name, date of receipt and amount of the contributions for which a 48-hour notice was not filed.

In accordance with the schedule of civil money penalties outlined within 11 C.F.R §111.44, this committee should be assessed the civil money penalty so indicated.

Recommendation

1. Find reason to believe that John Hall for Congress and Karen M. Haight, Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6) and make a preliminary determination that a civil money penalty of \$5,636.00 be assessed.
2. Send the appropriate letter.

Dear Karen M. Haight:

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify in writing either the Secretary of the Senate or the Federal Election Commission ("FEC"), and the Secretary of State, as appropriate, of any contribution of \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before, any election. The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. 434(a). You were previously notified of the requirement to file these notices. Records at the FEC indicate that you did not submit 48-Hour Notices for contributions of \$1,000 or more, received between 10/19/2006 and 11/4/2006, totaling \$44,261.08. See Attachment 1 for contribution overview.

The Act was further amended in 1999 to permit the FEC to impose civil money penalties for violations of the reporting requirements of 2 U.S.C. 434(a). 2 U.S.C. 437g(a)(4). On 5/2/2007, the FEC found that there is Reason to Believe ("RTB") that John Hall for Congress and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. 434(a) by failing to file the 48-Hour Notices. Based on the FEC's schedule of civil money penalties at 11 C.F.R. 111.44, the amount of your civil money penalty calculated at the RTB stage is \$5,636. Send your payment by 6/11/2007. The amount of the civil money penalty is \$110 for each non-filed notice plus 10 percent of the dollar amount of the contributions not timely reported. The civil money penalty increases by 25 percent for each prior violation.

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To Pay the Calculated Civil Money Penalty

To pay the calculated civil money penalty, send the enclosed remittance and your payment to the FEC at the address on page 4. Upon receipt of your payment, the FEC will send you a final determination letter.

To Challenge the RTB Finding and/or Calculated Civil Money Penalty

To challenge the RTB finding and/or calculated civil money penalty, you must submit a written response, including the AF# found on page one, to the FEC's Office of Administrative Review, 999 E Street, NW, Washington, DC 20463. Your response must be received by 6/11/2007. Your written response must include the reason(s) why you are challenging the RTB finding and/or calculated civil money penalty. The FEC will only consider challenges that are based on a factual error, miscalculation of the calculated civil money penalty by the FEC, or the existence of extraordinary circumstances that persisted for more than 48 hours that were beyond your control and prevented you from filing the report in a timely manner. Your response must include the factual basis supporting the reason(s) and supporting documentation. The FEC strongly encourages that documents be submitted in the form of affidavits or declarations. Examples of circumstances that will not be considered extraordinary include, but are not limited to, negligence, problems with vendors or contractors, staff illness, computer failures and similar circumstances. 11 C.F.R. 111.35(b)(1)(iii) and (4).

Your failure to raise an argument in a timely fashion during the administrative process shall be deemed a waiver of your right to present such argument in a petition to the district court under 2 U.S.C. 437g. 11 C.F.R. 111.38.

If you intend to be represented by counsel, please advise the Office of Administrative Review. You should provide, in writing, the name, address and telephone number of your counsel and authorize counsel to receive notifications and communications relating to this challenge and imposition of the calculated civil money penalty.

If You Do Not Pay the Calculated Civil Money Penalty or Submit a Challenge

If you do not pay the calculated civil money penalty or submit a written response, the FEC will assume that the preceding factual allegations are true and make a final determination that John Hall for Congress and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty.


Unpaid civil money penalties assessed through the Administrative Fine regulations will be subject to the Debt Collection Act of 1982 ("DCA") as amended by the Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996, 31 U.S.C. 3701 et seq. The FEC may take any and all appropriate action authorized and required by the DCA, as amended, including transfer to the U.S. Department of the Treasury for collection. 11 C.F.R. 111.45.

This matter was generated based on information ascertained by the FEC in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. 2 U.S.C. 437g(a)(2). It will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A) until it is placed on the public record in accordance with 11 C.F.R. 111.42, unless you notify the FEC in writing that you wish the matter to be made public.

Campaigns that raise or spend more than \$5,000 for the 2006 election cycle (and thus trigger registration and reporting requirements) must file quarterly reports throughout 2006, even if the candidate plans to retire, withdraws from the race prior to the primary election, loses the primary or drops out of the race prior to the general election. Committees must continue to file reports until the Commission notifies them in writing that their termination report has been accepted.

48 HOUR NOTICES ON CONTRIBUTIONS

Notices are required if the committee receives contributions (including in-kind gifts or advances of goods or services; Loans from the candidate or other non-bank sources; and guarantees or endorsements of bank loans to the candidate or committee) of \$1,000 or more, during the period of October 19 through November 4, 2006.

The notices must reach the appropriate federal filing office within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s). Senate candidates must transmit them to the Secretary of the Senate at (202) 224-1851. **Campaign committees that file electronically MUST submit their 48-hour notices electronically.** For more information, visit the FEC web site at www.fec.gov/electfil/online.shtml. U.S. House candidates faxing 48-hour notices should transmit them to the FEC at (202) 219-0174.

¹These dates indicate the beginning and the end of the reporting period. A reporting period always begins the day after the closing date of the last report filed. If the committee is new and has not previously filed a report, the first report must cover all activity that occurred before the committee registered.

²An individual becomes a candidate for Federal office (and thus triggers registration and reporting obligations) when his or her campaign exceeds \$5,000 in either contributions received or expenditures made. If the campaign has not exceeded the \$5,000 threshold, it is not required to file reports.

³If the campaign has more than one authorized committee in addition to the principal campaign committee, the principal campaign committee must also file a consolidated report on Form 3Z.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule A of your report discloses one or more contributions that appear to exceed the limits set forth in the Act (see attached). You should examine all of your contributions to check for additional excessive contributions. The Committee's procedures for processing contributions should also be reviewed.

An authorized or principal campaign committee may not make a contribution(s) to a candidate for federal office in excess of \$2,000 per election. The term "contribution" includes any gift, subscription, loan, advance, or deposit of money or anything of value made by any person for the purpose of influencing any election for federal office. (2 U.S.C. § 441a(a) and (f); 11 CFR §§ 102.12(c) and 102.13(c))

If any apparently excessive contribution in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you must amend your original report with the clarifying information. If any contribution you received exceeds the limits, you may have to refund the excessive amount.

The funds can be retained if within sixty (60) days of receipt, the excessive amount was properly designated for a different election, by obtaining signed written authorization from the contributor(s) pursuant to 11 CFR §§ 110.1(b)(5) and 110.2(b)(5). Any request from a donor for a refund must be honored.

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If the foregoing conditions for redesignations were not met within 60 days of receipt, the excessive amount must be refunded. See 11 CFR § 103.3(b)(1).

Please inform the Commission of your corrective action immediately in writing and provide a photocopy of any refund checks and/or letters redesignating the contributions in question. Refunds are reported on Line 20 of the Detailed Summary Page and on a supporting Schedule B of the report covering the period in which they are made. Redesignations are reported as memo entries on Schedule A of the report covering the period in which the authorization for the redesignation is received. (11 CFR § 104.8(d)(2), (3) and (4))

The acceptance of excessive contributions is a serious problem. Although the Commission may take further legal action, prompt action by you to refund or seek redesignation of the excessive amount will be taken into consideration.

-Schedule A of your report discloses one or more contributions received after the general election that are designated for the general (see attached). These contributions may only be accepted to the extent that the committee has net debts outstanding from the general election. (11 CFR § 110.1(b)(3)(i))

A contribution is considered made when the contributor relinquishes control over the contribution. If any contribution in question was incompletely or incorrectly reported, you must amend your original report with the clarifying information.

If a contribution exceeds the amount of net debts outstanding from the general election, you may have to refund or redesignate the contribution.

The funds can be retained if within sixty (60) days of receipt the excessive amount was properly redesignated for a different election. An excessive contribution is considered properly redesignated if (1) the committee obtains signed written documentation from the contributor(s) authorizing

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the redesignation of the contribution for another election provided that the new designation does not exceed the limitations on contributions made with respect to that election, or (2) the committee redesignates by presumption the excessive portion of the contribution for another election provided that the new designation does not exceed the limitations on contributions made with respect to that election. In this case, the treasurer must notify the contributor of the redesignation in writing within 60 days of the treasurer's receipt of the contribution. The notification must give the contributor an opportunity to request a refund. (11 CFR § 110.1(b)(5)(ii)(B))

If the foregoing conditions for redesignations are not met within 60 days of receipt, the excessive amount must be refunded. See 11 CFR § 103.3(b)(1).



Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW ("OAR")**

AF# 1695 – John Hall for Congress and Karen M. Haight, as Treasurer (C00417451)

On May 2, 2007, the Commission found reason to believe ("RTB") that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file 48-Hour Notices for 24 contributions of \$1,000 or more received between October 19 and November 4, 2006 totaling \$44,261.08 and made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$5,636 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.44. They were notified by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") on May 4, 2007 of the Commission's RTB finding and civil money penalty.

Respondents' Response

On June 4, 2007, the Commission received the written response and supporting documentation ("challenge") from the Treasurer who says that there are "valid explanations" for why they did not file 48-Hour Notices for more than half of the contributions listed in the RTB letter.¹ For the remaining contributions, the Treasurer notes that she was unprepared for the level of activity they had during the 48-Hour Notice period leading up to the general election. Although an effort was made to account for all contributions received during the 48-Hour Notice period, she later discovered some contributions were missed.

Submitted with the challenge are copies of various documents. The first document lists eight contributions (Exhibits 1 through 8); supporting documentation is provided for these Exhibits. The Treasurer says that seven contributions (Exhibits 1 through 3 and 5 through 8) were received after the 48-Hour Notice reporting period. For the eighth contribution labeled Exhibit 4, she says that they received two contributions from this contributor, disclosed one on a 48-Hour Notice, and later returned the second contribution because it was excessive. With respect to the "on-line contributions" (Exhibits 9a and 9b), the Treasurer says that these, along with some checks received in the mail, were not reported because the filing software did not take into account contributions received or recorded later on the same day after she had run the report.

The second document is a chart with 24 contributions listed on it. The contribution amount and "Ck or CC Date," which appears to be the check or credit card date, is provided for each contributor. An exhibit number is provided for 14 contributions; the "Source" is provided for 17 contributions; and the "Date Received" is given for 15 contributions. Supporting documentation is not provided for contributions labeled Exhibits 9a through 9f.

Analysis

The Federal Election Campaign Act ("Act") requires that the principal campaign committee of a candidate must notify the Commission, in writing, of any contribution of \$1,000 or more received after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before the 2006 General Election. The principal campaign committee must notify the Commission within 48 hours of receipt of the contribution. The 48-hour notification shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements

¹ Lee Kyriacou was designated as the new Treasurer in May 2007, following Ms. Haight's resignation.

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under the Act. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(f). Each person who receives a contribution in excess of \$200 for an authorized committee shall forward the receipt date and contributor's identification with the contribution. The date of receipt shall be the date on which the person obtains possession of the contribution. 11 C.F.R. § 102.8(a). In-kind contributions shall be reported as a contribution in accordance with 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a). 11 C.F.R. § 104.13(a)(1). The recipient committee of an earmarked contribution shall include in its report the total amount received from the conduit and the date of receipt. 11 C.F.R. § 110.6(c)(2). The treasurer shall be personally responsible for the timely filing of reports. 11 C.F.R. § 104.14(d).

Contributions Received after the 48-Hour Notice Period

The documentation submitted for contributions totaling \$10,200 labeled Exhibits 1, 3, 7, and 8 discloses that they were received on November 10, 11, and 15. Instead of using the date on which they received these four contributions from either the original contributor or conduit as the receipt date, the respondents' documentation shows that they incorrectly used the check date or the date on which the conduit received the contributor's check as the receipt date. Because their documentation demonstrates that they received these four contributions outside the 48-Hour Notice reporting period, the respondents were not required to include them on 48-Hour Notices.

The Treasurer previously acknowledged in her January 2007 response to RAD's request that they "do need to improve our system of reporting contributions by the date received instead of check date or deposit date." With respect to the 48-Hour Notices which were not filed, she explains that "[t]here were checks entered with the check date instead of the received date and we have corrected these."

Their amended 30 Day Post General Report filed in April 2007, however, still discloses the wrong dates as the receipt dates. The Reviewing Officer spoke with the Treasurer and a Committee representative, and explained that there are discrepancies between the receipt dates listed on this amended report and the documentation provided with the challenge. The Reviewing Officer recommended that they review their contribution records and amend the 30 Day Post General Report to disclose the correct receipt dates. As of this date, they have not amended the report to correct the receipt date discrepancies.

In-Kind Contributions

The documentation submitted for contributions totaling \$4,361.08 labeled Exhibits 2, 5 and 6 discloses that they were in-kind contributions received for events held on October 29 and November 2. Instead of using the date on which they actually received the benefit of these in-kind contributions (the date of the event) as the receipt date, their documentation indicates that they used the date on which they received the contributors' emails with the final accounting for the events' costs.² Because their documentation indicates that these in-kind contributions were

²In two Advisory Opinions, the Commission addresses receipt dates of in-kind contributions. In Advisory Opinion 1992-33, the Commission explains how to report the receipt of an in-kind contribution of flowers for a fundraising event: the committee reports "the date the committee receives the flowers, e.g., the date of the fundraiser" and "[i]f there are other such in-kind contributions on that date for the fundraiser, those amounts should also be included." In Advisory Opinion 2004-36, the Commission states how to report the receipt of an in-kind contribution of rent: "[a]ssuming the rent is due the first of each month ..., the Committee must report and itemize the in-kind contributions of office space for August 1 and September 1 on ... the ... October Quarterly Report."

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for events held on October 29 and November 2, both of which occurred during the 48-Hour Notice reporting period, the respondents were required to include them on 48-Hour Notices.

Excessive Contribution (Exhibit 4)

It appears that the respondents received two \$2,000 contributions on November 1 and 3 from an authorized committee, and then refunded \$1,000 to the donor committee in January 2007. Only the November 3rd contribution appears on a 48-Hour Notice. Since it appears that they actually received two \$2,000 contributions during the 48 Hour Notice reporting period, they were required to disclose both of them on 48 Hour Notices. The fact that they refunded \$1,000 to the contributor more than two months later does not change the requirement to report the initial receipt of both contributions.

Missed Contributions

Apart from two contributions (Exhibits 9a and 9b), they do not identify which other contributions on the chart fall into this category but it appears to include 13 contributions totaling \$25,700. For four of these contributions (Exhibits 9c through 9f), the receipt date is the same as the check or credit card date. For nine contributions received online with no Exhibit numbers, only the check or credit card dates are provided; however, the amended report discloses receipt dates that are the same as the check or credit card dates. Because all of the receipt dates fall within the 48-Hour Notice reporting period and they have not provided any documentation to the contrary, they were required to disclose these 15 contributions on 48 Hour-Notices.

Hopefund, Inc.

This contribution is listed on the chart with a check or credit card date of November 4 and a receipt date of November 6. The amended report, however discloses a receipt date of November 4 which is consistent with the Treasurer's January 2007 response that they used the check or deposit date as the receipt date instead of the actual date on which they got the contribution. Because the November 6 receipt date falls outside the 48-Hour reporting period, they were not required to report this contribution on a 48-Hour Notice. As of this date, they have not amended the report to disclose the correct receipt date.

At the time of the RTB finding, it appeared that the respondents failed to file 48-Hour Notices for 24 contributions totaling \$44,261.08 which were received on 11 days (October 19, 23, 26, 28, 29, 30, 31, and November 1, 2, 3, and 4, 2006). Based on the challenge and documentation, they were not required to 48-Hour Notices for 5 contributions totaling \$11,200. Further review by this Office indicates that they were not required to file a 48-Hour Notice for the \$1,000 contribution received from Bevis and Clara Longstreth: this contribution is reported as a joint contribution and would result in a contribution of less than \$1,000 from each individual. The Reviewing Officer has, therefore, determined that they did not file 48-Hour Notices for 18 contributions totaling \$32,061 received on 11 days (see Chart at Attachment 3). Under the administrative fine regulations, the civil money penalty is \$110 plus 10% of the amount of the contributions not reported on a 48-Hour Notice. 11 C.F.R. § 111.44. The amount of the civil money penalty would be \$1,210 + (.10 x \$32,061) or \$4,416 (reduced from the RTB civil money penalty of \$5,636).

Their challenge (including that the Treasurer had not previously worked on a Federal campaign) fails to address any of the three valid excuses enumerated at 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b). These are: (i) the RTB finding is based on factual errors; and/or (ii) the improper calculation of

the civil money penalty; and/or (iii) they used best efforts to file on time but were prevented from doing so by reasonably unforeseen circumstances that were beyond their control and they filed the report no later than 24 hours after the end of these circumstances. The Reviewing Officer, therefore, recommends that the Commission make a final determination that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$4,416.

OAR Recommendations

- (1) Adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for AF# 1695 involving John Hall for Congress and Karen M. Haight, as Treasurer, in making the final determination;
- (2) Make a final determination in AF# 1695 that John Hall for Congress and Karen M. Haight, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$4,416 (reduced from the RTB civil money penalty of \$5,636); and
- (3) Send the appropriate letter.



2. The principal campaign committee of a congressional candidate must file notifications disclosing contributions of \$1,000 or more which are received between October 19 and November 4, 2006. These notifications (also called 48-Hour Notices) must be filed with the Commission within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s).
3. I hereby certify that I have searched the Commission's public records and that the documents identified herein are true and accurate copies of:
 - a) Pages 1 and 2 of the 48-Hour Notice filed by John Hall for Congress and Karen M. Haight, as Treasurer. According to Commission records, the Notice was received on November 3, 2006. On Page 2, it lists a \$2,000.00 contribution received from Higgins for Congress on November 3, 2006;
 - b) electronic amendment received January 28, 2007 from John Hall for Congress and Karen M. Haight, as Treasurer. According to Commission records, the amendment references the letter sent for the 30 Day Post General Report. It states that, for the "excessive contribution by the Brian Higgins for Congress Committee[, w]e have issued a refund ... to correct this.... In regard to the contributions listed as being received after the general election, all of those listed were received prior to the election. We do need to improve our system of reporting contributions by the date received instead of check date or deposit date. We have corrected the dates for those contributions.... As for the missing 48-hour notices – there were several procedural problems.... There were checks entered with the check date instead of the received date and we have corrected these. There were three in-kind contributions that we were not notified of until after the reporting period had passed. The rest ... missed the reports because of the way I was selecting the date range of contributions for the list each day;"
 - c) Page 1 of the Summary Page and 24 pages of Schedule A for the amended 2006 30 Day Post-General Report filed by John Hall for Congress and Karen M. Haight, as Treasurer. According to Commission records, the report covers the period from October 19 through November 27, 2006, and was received on April 10, 2007. Schedule A lists the receipt of 25 contributions totaling \$46,261.08 on October 19, 26, 28, 29, and 31, and November 1, 2, 3, and 4, 2006. Each contribution equals \$1,000 or more;
 - d) Page 1 of the Summary Page and Page 249 of Schedule B for the 2007 April Quarterly Report filed by John Hall for Congress and Karen M. Haight, as Treasurer. According to Commission records, the report was received on April 15 2007. On Schedule B for Line 21, it lists a \$1,000.00 refund made January 20, 2007 to "Brian Higgins for Congress;" and
 - e) Pages 1 and 3 of the Statement of Organization filed by John Hall for Congress and Lee Kyriacou, as Treasurer. According to Commission records, the Statement was received May 17, 2007. On Page 3, it lists Lee Kyriacou as Treasurer on Line 8.

In regard to the contributions listed as being received after the general election, all of those listed were received prior to the election. We do need to improve our system of reporting contributions by the date received instead of check date or deposit date. We have corrected the dates for those contributions. Because of this correction it has become obvious that two contributors have exceeded their contribution limit for the period and we have issued refund checks to these people.

We believe that the discrepancy in our cycle-to-date totals was caused by the changes we had made in prior periods but we did not amended reports until after we filed the 30-Day Post General report. It looks to me like this will correct itself with this amended report.

As for the missing 48-hour notices - there were several procedural problems that caused the list to be so long.

There were checks entered with the check date instead of the received date and we have corrected these.

There were three in-kind contributions that we were not notified of until after the reporting period had passed.

The rest of the contributions missed the reports because of the way I was selecting the date range of contributions for the list each day.

We are working on setting up a written procedure so that in the future we can avoid the problems we had this year.

The Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$5,636 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.44.

On May 2, 2007, the Commission found reason to believe that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file 48-Hour Notices for 24 contributions of \$1,000 or more received between October 19 and November 4, 2006, totaling \$44,261.08. The Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$5,636 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.44.

On June 4, 2007, the Commission received the respondents' written response ("challenge"). After reviewing the challenge, the Reviewing Officer's recommendation dated January 30, 2008 was forwarded to the Commission. A copy was simultaneously forwarded to the respondents. The Reviewing Officer determined that the respondents were not required to file 48-Hour Notices for six contributions totaling \$12,200. The Reviewing Officer, therefore, recommended that the Commission make a final determination that they violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$4,416 (reduced from the RTB civil money penalty of \$5,636) because they submitted no evidence that a factual error was made, that the civil money penalty was miscalculated at RTB or that extraordinary circumstances existed which prevented them from filing 48-Hour Notices for 18 contributions totaling \$32,061.08 received between October 19 and November 4, 2006.

Within 10 days of transmittal of the recommendation, the respondents may file a written response with the Commission Secretary which may not raise any arguments not

raised in the respondents' challenge or not directly responsive to the Reviewing Officer's recommendation. 11 C.F.R. § 111.36(f). As of this date, a written response has not been received.

On May 2, 2007, the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") found reason to believe ("RTB") that John Hall for Congress and you, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file 48-Hour Notices for 24 contributions totaling \$44,261.08 for the 2006 General Election. By letter dated May 4, 2007, the Commission sent you notification of the RTB finding that included a civil money penalty calculated at RTB of \$5,636 in accordance with the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.44. On June 4, 2007, the Office of Administrative Review received the written response from you challenging the RTB finding.

The Reviewing Officer reviewed the Commission's RTB finding with its supporting documentation and your written response. Based on this review, it was determined that the respondents were not required to file 48-Hour Notices for six contributions totaling \$12,200. Therefore, the Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission make a final determination that John Hall for Congress and you, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file 48-Hour Notices for 18 contributions totaling \$32,061 received between October 19 and November 4, 2006, and assess a civil money penalty in the amount of \$4,416 in accordance with 11 C.F.R. § 111.44. The basis for the Reviewing Officer's recommendation was included in the Final Determination Report, a copy of which was sent to you on January 31, 2008.

On January 30, 2009, the Commission adopted the Reviewing Officer's recommendation and made a final determination that John Hall for Congress and you, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assessed a civil money penalty of \$4,416 (reduced from the RTB civil money penalty of \$5,636). A copy of the final determination recommendation is attached.

To Pay the Civil Money Penalty

If you should decide to pay the civil money penalty, send the enclosed form and payment to the address on page 3 within 30 days of receipt of this letter.

If You Do Not Pay the Civil Money Penalty

Unpaid civil money penalties assessed through the Administrative Fine regulations will be subject to the Debt Collection Act of 1982 ("DCA") as amended by the Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996 ("DCIA"), 31 U.S.C. § 3701 et seq. If you do not pay this debt within 30 days (or file a written petition to a federal district court - see below), the Commission will transfer the debt to the U.S. Department of the Treasury ("Treasury") for collection. Within 5 days of the transfer to Treasury, Treasury will contact the debtor and request payment. Treasury currently charges a fee of 28% of the civil money penalty amount for its collection services. The fee will be added to the amount of the civil money penalty that you owe. Should Treasury's attempts fail, Treasury will refer the debt to a private collection agency ("PCA"). If the debt remains unpaid, Treasury may recommend that the Commission refer the matter to the Department of Justice for litigation.


If You Choose to Appeal the Final Determination and/or Civil Money Penalty

If you choose to appeal the final determination, you should submit a written petition, within 30 days of receipt of this letter, to the district court of the United States for the district in which the committee or treasurer reside, or transact business, requesting that the final determination be modified or set aside. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(C)(iii). Your failure to raise an argument in a timely fashion during the administrative process shall be deemed a waiver of the respondents' right to present such argument in a petition to the district court under 2 U.S.C. § 437g. 11 C.F.R. § 111.38.

The confidentiality provisions at 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12) no longer apply and this matter is now public. The file will be made a part of the public record pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 111.42(b). Although the file must be placed on the public record within 30 days from the date of the Commission's notification, this could occur at any time following certification of the Commission's vote.
