Attached is a list of political committees and their treasurers who failed to file the 2008 July Quarterly Report in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 434(a). The July Quarterly Report was due on July 15, 2008.

The committees listed in the attached RTB Circulation Report either failed to file the report, filed the report more than five (5) days after the due date, or filed the report more than thirty (30) days after the due date (considered a non-filed report). In accordance with the schedule of civil money penalties for reports at 11 CFR 111.43, these committees should be assessed the civil money penalties highlighted on the attached circulation report.

**Recommendation**

1. Find reason to believe that the political committees and their treasurers listed on the RTB Circulation Report violated 2 U.S.C. 434(a) and make a preliminary determination that the civil money penalties would be the amounts indicated on the RTB Circulation Report.
2. Send the appropriate letters.

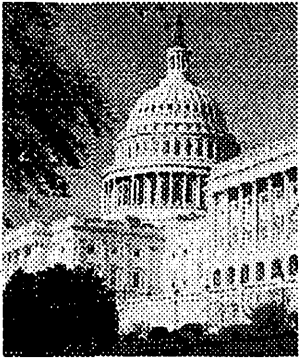

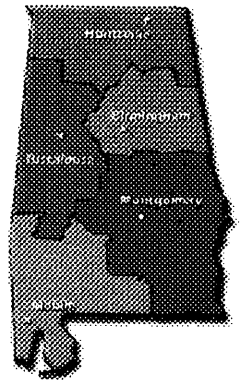



Committee treasurers must comply with all applicable filing deadlines established by law, and the lack of prior notice does not constitute an excuse for failing to comply with any filing deadline.

### WHO MUST FILE

Principal campaign committees of congressional candidates<sup>3</sup> (including unopposed candidates and candidates whose names do not appear on the ballot) must file a July Quarterly Report by July 15, 2008.<sup>4</sup>

Campaigns that raise or spend more than \$5,000 for the 2008 election cycle (and thus trigger registration and reporting requirements) must file quarterly reports throughout 2008, even if the candidate plans to retire, withdraws from the race prior to the primary election, loses the primary or drops out of the race prior to the general election. Before a committee can stop filing with the FEC, it must file a termination report with the Commission. Committees must continue to file reports until the Commission notifies them in writing that their termination report has been accepted.

### METHODS OF FILING REPORTS

#### Electronic Filing

Reports filed electronically must be received and validated by the Commission by 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time on the filing deadline. For additional information, call the Electronic Filing Office at (800) 424-9530 or (202) 694-1642 or visit our website at [www.fec.gov/elecfil/electron.shtml](http://www.fec.gov/elecfil/electron.shtml).

Under the Commission's mandatory electronic filing regulations, U.S. House committees that receive contributions or make expenditures in excess of \$50,000 in a calendar year, or that have reason to expect to do so, must file all reports and statements with the FEC electronically. Other U.S. House committees may voluntarily file electronically; however, any entity that files electronically, whether required to do so or not, must comply with the electronic filing rules. U.S. Senate committees that file with the Secretary of the Senate are not subject to the mandatory electronic filing rules, but may file an unofficial copy of their reports with the Commission in order to speed disclosure.

#### Registered & Certified Mail

Reports sent by Registered or Certified Mail must be postmarked on or before the mailing deadline to be considered timely filed. A committee sending its reports by Certified Mail should keep its certified mailing receipt with the U.S. Postal Service (USPS) postmark as proof of filing because the USPS does not keep complete records of items sent by Certified Mail. A committee sending its report by Registered Mail should keep its proof of mailing. Note that a Certificate of Mailing from the USPS is not sufficient to prove that a report is timely filed using Registered, Certified or Overnight Mail.

#### Overnight Mail

Reports filed via overnight mail will be considered timely filed if the report is received by the delivery service on or before the mailing deadline. "Overnight mail" includes Priority or Express Mail having a delivery confirmation, or an overnight delivery service with which the report is scheduled for next business day delivery and is recorded in the service's on-line tracking system.

<sup>3</sup>Generally, an individual becomes a candidate for Federal office (and thus triggers registration and reporting obligations) when his or her campaign exceeds \$5,000 in either contributions received or expenditures made. If the campaign has not exceeded the \$5,000 threshold, it is not required to file reports. See 11 CFR 100.3(a).

<sup>4</sup>If a candidate has more than one authorized committee, the principal campaign committee must also file a consolidated report on Form 3Z.

### Other Means of Filing

Reports filed by any other means—including first class mail and courier—must be received by the Commission (or for Senate committees, the Secretary of the Senate) before the close of business on the last business day before the filing deadline.

Forms are available for downloading and printing at the FEC website at [www.fec.gov/info/forms.shtml](http://www.fec.gov/info/forms.shtml).

### 48 HOUR NOTICES ON CONTRIBUTIONS

Notices are required if the committee receives any contribution (including in-kind gifts or advances of goods or services; Loans from the candidate or other non-bank sources; and guarantees or endorsements of bank loans to the candidate or committee) of \$1,000 or more per source, during the period less than 20 days but more than 48 hours before any election in which the candidate is running.

The notices, which may be filed using Form 6, or under limited circumstances Form 10, must reach the appropriate federal and/or state filing office(s) within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s). U.S. Senate candidates must transmit the notices to the Secretary of the Senate by fax at (202) 224-1851. **Campaign committees that file electronically MUST submit their 48-hour notices electronically.** For more information, visit the FEC web site at [www.fec.gov/electfil/online.shtml](http://www.fec.gov/electfil/online.shtml).

U.S. House candidates faxing 48-hour notices should transmit them to the FEC at (202) 219-0174. Paper forms are available at the FEC web site at [www.fec.gov/info/forms.shtml](http://www.fec.gov/info/forms.shtml).

### COMPLIANCE

**Treasurer Responsibility.** Treasurers of political committees are responsible for both the timeliness and the accuracy of all reports. They may be subject to monetary penalties if reports are inaccurate or are not filed on time. For additional information, see the Commission's *Statement of Policy Regarding Treasurers Subject to Enforcement Proceedings* on the web site at [www.fec.gov/law/policy/2004/notice2004-20.pdf](http://www.fec.gov/law/policy/2004/notice2004-20.pdf).

**Administrative Fine Program.** Under the Administrative Fine Program, political committees and their treasurers who fail to file their reports on time may be subject to civil money penalties up to \$16,000 (or more for repeat late- and non-filers).<sup>5</sup> For additional information, visit the FEC website at [www.fec.gov/af/af.shtml](http://www.fec.gov/af/af.shtml).

**Report Format.** In addition, political committees that file illegible reports or use non-FEC forms (except for FEC-approved, computer-generated forms) will be required to refile their reports.

**Electronic Filers Must File Electronically.** Electronic filers who instead file on paper, or who submit an electronic report (either by direct transmission, 3.5" diskette or CD) that does not pass the validation program by 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time on the filing deadline, will be considered non-filers and may be subject to enforcement actions (including administrative fines).

### IMPORTANT FILING INFORMATION - PAPER FILERS

In response to the anthrax threat, the U.S. Postal Service is irradiating mail directed to many federal agencies, including the FEC and the Secretary of the Senate.<sup>6</sup> This process has not only delayed mail delivery, it has also damaged and in some cases destroyed pieces of mail. As a result, committees that file reports with the FEC may want to consider submitting their reports by some means other than U.S. mail. Alternative methods include electronic filing, overnight mail service, and hand delivery.

<sup>5</sup>Penalties for late- or non-filing of 48-hour notices are based on the amount of contributions not timely disclosed. As a result, these penalties may exceed \$16,000, even for first-time violations.

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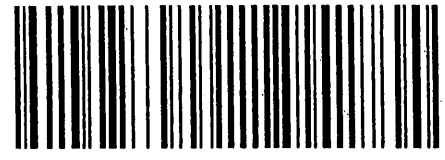

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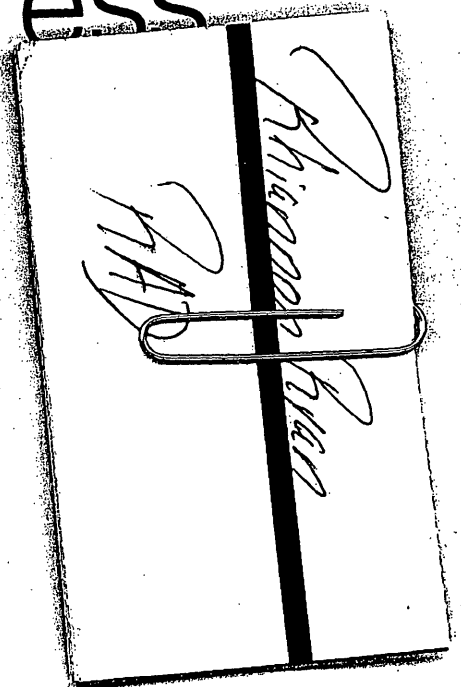

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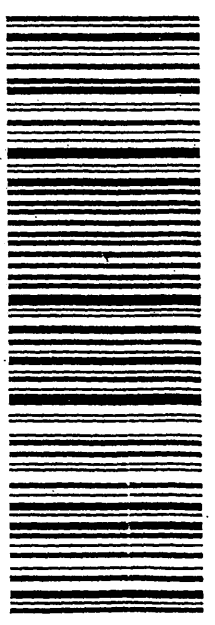

AF# 1829 and 1872 – Swanson for US Senate Committee and Johnny Swanson, III, as Treasurer  
(C00359695)

On September 18 and 19, 2008, the Commission found reason to believe ("RTB") that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file the 2008 12 Day Pre-Primary Report and 2008 July Quarterly Report, respectively, and made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$900 for each report based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. They were notified by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") on September 19 and 22, 2008, respectively, of the Commission's RTB findings and civil money penalties. The letters were sent to their address of record; copies were sent to them at 1725 4<sup>th</sup> Ave West, Birmingham, AL 35208.

**Respondents' Response**

On October 15, 2008, the Commission received the written response ("challenge") from the Treasurer for both cases requesting that the Commission remove or reduce the findings and/or penalties. The Treasurer asserts that the 12 Day Pre-Primary Report was filed, but filed late. The Treasurer acknowledges that the July Quarterly Report was filed extremely late due to the death of the campaign manager as well as the Treasurer's illness and subsequent hospitalization. Furthermore, the Treasurer believed that the new campaign manager would file the July Quarterly Report. He also references the Committee's October Quarterly Report, which was filed timely.

The response includes two copies of the Summary and Detailed Summary Pages for the July Quarterly Report, which shows \$0 in activity for the period, and two copies of the Summary and Detailed Summary Pages for the October Quarterly Report for the Swanson for Senate Committee. It also includes two copies of the Summary and Detailed Summary Pages for the July Quarterly Report and the Summary and Detailed Summary Pages for the October Quarterly Report for The Swanson Circle committee. Copies of the challenge and the RTB letter for AF # 1829 are also included in the response.

**Analysis**

The 12 Day Pre-Primary Report was filed, via certified mail, on June 9, 2008, 18 days late. The July Quarterly Report was filed, via overnight delivery, on October 14, 2008, 90 days late.

The Federal Election Campaign Act ("Act") states that the treasurer of a principal campaign committee shall file a report no later than the 12th day before (or posted by certified mail no later than the 15th day before) any election in which the candidate is seeking election, or nomination for election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(i) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(a)(2)(i)(A). The Act states that the treasurer of a principal campaign committee shall file a report for the period ending June 30 no later than July 15. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(a)(1)(i).

The treasurer shall be personally responsible for the timely filing of reports. 11 C.F.R. § 104.14(d).

The Treasurer correctly asserts that the 12 Day Pre-Primary Report was filed, but filed late. The 12 Day Pre-Primary Report is an election sensitive report. 11 C.F.R. § 111.43(d). An election sensitive report that is not filed more than four days prior to the election (June 3, 2008) is considered not filed for the purpose of the civil money penalty calculation. 11 C.F.R. § 111.43(e)(2). The RTB civil money penalty for the 12 Day Pre-Primary Report is correct (\$900) as the report was filed six days after the Primary.

With respect to the July Quarterly Report, the Reviewing Officer is sympathetic about the campaign manager's death and the hospitalization of the Treasurer; however, the illness and unavailability of the Treasurer and other staff are included at 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(d) as examples of circumstances that are not considered reasonably unforeseen and beyond the respondents' control which prevented them from filing on time.

Another issue raised regarding the July Quarterly Report is the level of activity. At the time of the RTB finding, the Commission estimated the level of activity to be \$28,191 because no report was received. 11 C.F.R. § 111.43(a)(2)(ii) and (e). The July Quarterly Report, filed on October 14, 2008, discloses \$0 in receipts and \$0 in disbursements. Since the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43(a)(2)(iii) only provides for civil money penalties if the level of activity is \$1.00 or more, no civil money penalty should be assessed in this case.

Therefore, the Reviewing Officer recommends that the Commission make a final determination that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$900 in AF# 1829 and \$0 in AF# 1872 (reduced from the RTB civil money penalty of \$900).

#### **OAR Recommendations**

- (1) Adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for AF# 1829 involving the Swanson for US Senate Committee and Johnny Swanson, III, as Treasurer, in making the final determination;
- (2) Make a final determination in AF# 1829 that the Swanson for US Senate Committee and Johnny Swanson, III, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$900;
- (3) Adopt the Reviewing Office recommendation in AF# 1872 involving the Swanson for US Senate Committee and Johnny Swanson, III, as Treasurer;
- (4) Make a final determination in AF# 1872 that the Swanson for US Senate Committee and Johnny Swanson, III, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and, based on the actual level of activity disclosed on the July Quarterly Report (\$0), assess a civil money penalty of \$0 (reduced from the RTB civil money penalty of \$900); and
- (5) Send the appropriate letters.



The Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$900 for each report based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43.

After reviewing the written response and any supplemental information submitted by you and Commission staff, the Reviewing Officer has recommended that the Commission make a final determination in this matter. A copy of the Reviewing Officer's recommendation is attached.

You may file with the Commission Secretary a written response to the recommendation within 10 days of the date of this letter. 

Further, in regards to AF#1829, we operated with approxiametely six individuals to conduct this campaign. Two quit at the start of the campaign because we had no money for salaries, one found full time work and quit the majority of his activities. The balance were street venders putting up signs as they traveled around that state. I traveled from county to county speaking and handing out brochures as well as signs.

Finally, in regards to AF#1829, I am a disabled veteran, and I live on that income with less than \$15.00 left per month. I therefore ask that you consider reducing the assessment to \$0 in both actions.

On September 18 and 19, 2008, the Commission found reason to believe (“RTB”) that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file the 2008 12 Day Pre-Primary Report and 2008 July Quarterly Report, respectively. As a result, the Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$900 for each report based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43.

On October 14, 2008, the Committee filed the July Quarterly Report, 90 days late. It discloses \$0 in receipts and \$0 in disbursements. Since the report shows that the Committee had no activity during the July Quarterly reporting period and the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43(a)(2)(iii) only provides for civil money penalties if the level of activity is \$1.00 or more, no civil money penalty would have been assessed had the report been filed prior to the RTB finding.

On October 15, 2008, the Commission received their written response (“challenge”) for both cases. After reviewing the challenge, the Reviewing Officer’s recommendation dated November 19, 2008 was forwarded to the Commission, a copy was forwarded to the respondents, and is hereby incorporated by reference. The Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission make a final determination that they violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a \$900 civil money penalty in AF# 1829 and

\$0 in AF# 1872 because they submitted no evidence that a factual error was made in the RTB finding, that the penalty was miscalculated at RTB or that they used best efforts to file on time. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b).

Within 10 days of transmittal of the recommendation, they may file a written response with the Commission Secretary which may not raise any arguments not raised in their challenge or not directly responsive to the Reviewing Officer's recommendation. 11 C.F.R. § 111.36(f). On December 19 and 31, 2008, the Commission received their written response via mail and facsimile. A copy is attached.

After receipt of the response to the Reviewing Officer recommendations, the Treasurer, who is also the candidate, died. A copy of the death notice is attached for your review. Given that the Treasurer of record at the time of the late filing of both reports, who is also named as Treasurer in the RTB finding, submitted the challenge, and responded to the Reviewing Officer's recommendation, is now deceased, the Reviewing Officer recommends that the Commission not adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for these cases but, instead, terminate its proceedings in accordance with 11 C.F.R. § 111.37(b).

**OAR Recommendations**

- (1) Terminate the proceedings in AF# 1829 that the Swanson for US Senate Committee and Johnny Swanson, III, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and close the file;

On September 18 and 19, 2008, the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") found reason to believe ("RTB") that the Swanson for US Senate Committee and its Treasurer violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file the 2008 12 Day Pre-Primary Report and the 2008 July Quarterly Report, respectively. By letters dated September 19 and 22, 2008, respectively, the Commission sent the Committee notification of the RTB findings that included a civil money penalty calculated at RTB of \$900 for each report in accordance with the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. On October 15, 2008, the Office of Administrative Review received the written response challenging both cases.

The Reviewing Officer reviewed the Commission's RTB finding with its supporting documentation and the written response. After reviewing the challenge, the Reviewing Officer's recommendation dated November 19, 2008 was forwarded to the Commission, a copy was forwarded to the respondents, and is hereby incorporated by reference. The Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission make a final determination that they violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a \$900 civil money penalty in AF# 1829. The Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission reduce the civil money penalty in AF# 1972 because it was calculated on an estimated level of activity, make a final determination that they violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and, based on the level of activity disclosed on the July Quarterly Report filed October 14, 2008 (\$0), assess a civil money penalty of \$0 in accordance with 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. In both cases, the Reviewing Officer determined that they submitted no evidence that a factual error was made in the RTB finding, that the penalty was miscalculated at RTB or that they used best efforts to file on time. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b).

After receipt of the response to the Reviewing Officer recommendations, the Treasurer, who is also the candidate, died. Given that the Treasurer of record at the time of the late filing of both reports, who is also named as Treasurer in the RTB finding, submitted the challenge, and responded to the Reviewing Officer's recommendation, is now deceased, the Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission not adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for these cases but, instead, terminate its proceedings in accordance with 11 C.F.R. § 111.37(b). On April 16, 2009, the Commission adopted the Reviewing Officer recommendation and terminated its proceedings in both cases.

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The confidentiality provisions at 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12) no longer apply and this matter is now public. The file will be made a part of the public record pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 111.42(b). Although the file must be placed on the public record within 30 days from the date of the Commission's notification, this could occur at any time following certification of the Commission's vote.
