The committees listed in the attached RTB Circulation Report either failed to file the report, filed the report more than five (5) days after the due date, or filed the report more than thirty (30) days after the due date (considered a non-filed report). In accordance with the schedule of civil money penalties for reports at 11 CFR 111.43, these committees should be assessed the civil money penalties highlighted on the attached circulation report.

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires that your committee file an October Quarterly Report of Receipts and Disbursements every calendar year. This report, covering the period through September 30th, shall be filed no later than October 15th. 2 U.S.C. 434(a). Records at the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") indicate that this report was not filed within thirty (30) days of the due date. You should file this report if you have not already done so.

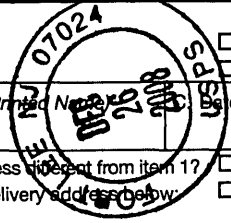

Campaigns that raise or spend more than \$5,000 for the 2008 election cycle (and thus trigger registration and reporting requirements) must file quarterly reports throughout 2008, even if the candidate plans to retire, withdraws from the race prior to the primary election, loses the primary or drops out of the race prior to the general election. Before a committee can stop filing with the FEC, it must file a termination report with the Commission. Committees must continue to file reports until the Commission notifies them in writing that their termination report has been accepted.

### METHODS OF FILING REPORTS

#### Electronic Filing

Reports filed electronically must be received and validated by the Commission by 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time on the filing deadline. For additional information, call the Electronic Filing Office at (800) 424-9530 or (202) 694-1642 or visit our website at [www.fec.gov/elecfil/electron.shtml](http://www.fec.gov/elecfil/electron.shtml).

Under the Commission's mandatory electronic filing regulations, U.S. House committees that receive contributions or make expenditures in excess of \$50,000 in a calendar year, or that have reason to expect to do so, must file all reports and statements with the FEC electronically. Other U.S. House committees may voluntarily file electronically; however, any entity that files electronically, whether required to do so or not, must comply with the electronic filing rules. U.S. Senate committees that file with the Secretary of the Senate are not subject to the mandatory electronic filing rules, but may file an unofficial copy of their reports with the Commission in order to speed disclosure.

#### Registered & Certified Mail

Reports sent by Registered or Certified Mail must be postmarked on or before the mailing deadline to be considered timely filed. A committee sending its reports by Certified Mail should keep its certified mailing receipt with the U.S. Postal Service (USPS) postmark as proof of filing because the USPS does not keep complete records of items sent by Certified Mail. A committee sending its report by Registered Mail should keep its proof of mailing. Note that a Certificate of Mailing from the USPS is not sufficient to prove that a report is timely filed using Registered, Certified or Overnight Mail.

#### Overnight Mail

Reports filed via overnight mail will be considered timely filed if the report is received by the delivery service on or before the mailing deadline. "Overnight mail" includes Priority or Express Mail having a delivery confirmation, or an overnight delivery service with which the report is scheduled for next business day delivery and is recorded in the service's on-line tracking system.

The notices, which may be filed using Form 6, or under limited circumstances Form 10, must reach the appropriate federal and/or state filing office(s) within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s). U.S. Senate candidates must transmit the notices to the Secretary of the Senate by fax at (202) 224-1851. **Campaign committees that file electronically MUST submit their 48-hour notices electronically.** For more information, visit the FEC web site at [www.fec.gov/electfil/online.shtml](http://www.fec.gov/electfil/online.shtml). U.S. House candidates faxing 48-hour notices should transmit them to the FEC at (202) 219-0174. Paper forms are available at the FEC web site at [www.fec.gov/info/forms.shtml](http://www.fec.gov/info/forms.shtml).

### COMPLIANCE

**Treasurer Responsibility.** Treasurers of political committees are responsible for both the timeliness and the accuracy of all reports. They may be subject to monetary penalties if reports are inaccurate or are not filed on time. For additional information, see the Commission's *Statement of Policy Regarding Treasurers Subject to Enforcement Proceedings* on the web site at [www.fec.gov/law/policy/2004/notice2004-20.pdf](http://www.fec.gov/law/policy/2004/notice2004-20.pdf).

**REVIEWING OFFICER RECOMMENDATION  
OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW ("OAR")**

AF# 1922 – Sabrin for Senate and Christopher R. Whalen, CPA, as Treasurer  
(C00443556)

On December 18, 2008, the Commission found reason to believe ("RTB") that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file the 2008 October Quarterly Report, a non-election sensitive report, and made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$500 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. They were notified by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") on December 22, 2008 of the Commission's RTB finding and civil money penalty.

**Respondents' Response**

On January 26, 2009, the Commission received the written response ("challenge") from the Treasurer requesting that the Commission remove the penalty. The Treasurer indicates that the report was timely filed by October 15, 2008. The challenge included copies of the RTB letter and the 2008 October Quarterly Report.

**Analysis**

The 2008 October Quarterly Report was filed via first class mail on November 10, 2008 and received on November 19, 2008, 35 days late.

The Federal Election Campaign Act ("Act") states that the treasurer of an authorized committee of a candidate shall file a report for the period ending September 30 no later than October 15. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(a)(1)(i). Quarterly reports sent by first class mail must be received by the close of business on the filing date to be timely filed. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(5) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 100.19(b)(2) and 104.5(e). The treasurer shall be personally responsible for the timely filing of reports. 11 C.F.R. § 104.14(d).

The Treasurer asserts that the October Quarterly Report was timely filed by October 15. Commission records show that the report was sent via first class mail and postmarked November 10. It was received by the Secretary of the Senate on November 19. In a conversation with the Reviewing Officer on March 3, 2009, the Superintendent of the Office of Public Records, Secretary of the Senate, said that her Office did not receive an October Quarterly Report from them in October; her Office did receive their October Quarterly Report, sent on November 10, on November 19.

While Commission records do not show the receipt of an October Quarterly Report in October, they do show the receipt of an amended July Quarterly Report. This amendment was sent by first class mail and received on October 17.

The Prior Notice for the October Quarterly Report, which was emailed to them on September 21, explains that, unless a report is sent by certified or registered mail and postmarked by the due date, or deposited with an overnight delivery service with an on-line tracking system by the due date, a report must be received by the filing date. Thus, the respondents were notified of the distinction between filing a report using first class mail, certified or registered mail, or an overnight delivery service. It is not clear why they did not use one of the safe harbor methods, as provided for at 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(5), as they did for earlier 2008 reports.

Therefore, the Reviewing Officer recommends that the Commission make a final determination that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$500.

#### **OAR Recommendations**

- (1) Adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for AF# 1922 involving Sabrin for Senate and Christopher R. Whalen, CPA, as Treasurer, in making the final determination;
- (2) Make a final determination in AF# 1922 that Sabrin for Senate and Christopher R. Whalen, CPA, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$500; and
- (3) Send the appropriate letter.

On December 18, 2008, the Commission found reason to believe (“RTB”) that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file the 2008 October Quarterly Report. As a result, the Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$500 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43.

On January 26, 2009, the Commission received their written response (“challenge”). After reviewing the challenge, the Reviewing Officer’s recommendation dated March 3, 2009 was forwarded to the Commission, a copy was forwarded to the respondents, and is hereby incorporated by reference. The Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission make a final determination that they violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a \$500 civil money penalty because they submitted no evidence that a factual error was made in the RTB finding, that the penalty was miscalculated at RTB or that they used best efforts to file on time. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b).

Within 10 days of transmittal of the recommendation, they may file a written response with the Commission Secretary which may not raise any arguments not raised in their challenge or not directly responsive to the Reviewing Officer’s recommendation. 11 C.F.R. § 111.36(f). A response was received from the Treasurer on March 9, 2009.

In the response, the Treasurer addresses the issue raised in the challenge and Reviewing Officer recommendation ("ROR"): the report was timely filed by October 15. He asserts that the original report was sent via first class mail, in plenty of time to the appropriate offices. He also provides new facts about this issue: the report submitted on November 10, 2008 was a duplicate sent out of professional courtesy because the Senate could not find the original report.

As explained in the ROR, there are several methods for treasurers to use to satisfy the Commission's timely filing requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(5), and 11 C.F.R. §§100.19(b) and 104.5(e). A report sent using one of the 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(5) "safe harbor" methods (certified or registered mail, Express or Priority mail with delivery confirmation, or overnight delivery service with online tracking scheduled for next business day delivery) is considered filed on the postmark or delivery submission date. Had the respondents sent the original October Quarterly Report by one of these methods and retained proof of that filing as treasurers are encouraged to do (see 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(i)), they could have used this evidence to demonstrate that the report was filed and that it was filed by October 15. But they opted to send the report by first class mail; therefore, the report is considered filed when it is received by the Secretary of the Senate's Office of Public Records. The Senate did not receive an October Quarterly Report from them by October 15. The Senate received their October Quarterly Report on November 19 which is considered the filing date.

The Treasurer also raises two issues that were not in the challenge and, therefore, not addressed in the ROR: the campaign is insolvent and the \$500 fine would be a hardship on his family. Because the new arguments were not raised in the challenge and, therefore, are not directly responsive to the Reviewing Officer's recommendation, they are not addressed by the Reviewing Officer in this memorandum. 11 C.F.R. § 111.36(f).

The Reviewing Officer recommends that the Commission make a final determination that they violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$500. On March 24, 2009, the Commission received the \$500 RTB civil money penalty.

### **OAR Recommendations**

- (1) Adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for AF# 1922 involving Sabrin for Senate and Christopher R. Whalen, CPA, as Treasurer, in making the final determination;
- (2) Make a final determination in AF# 1922 that Sabrin for Senate and Christopher R. Whalen, CPA, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$500; and
- (3) Send the appropriate letter.

On December 18, 2008, the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") found reason to believe ("RTB") that Sabrin for Senate and you, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file the 2008 October Quarterly Report, a non-election sensitive report. By letter dated December 22, 2008, the Commission sent you notification of the RTB finding that included a civil money penalty calculated at RTB of \$500 in accordance with the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. On January 26, 2009, the Office of Administrative Review received the written response from you challenging the RTB finding.

The Reviewing Officer reviewed the Commission's RTB finding with its supporting documentation and the written response. Based on this review, the Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission make a final determination that Sabrin for Senate and you, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty in the amount of \$500 in accordance with 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. The basis for the Reviewing Officer's recommendation was included in the Final Determination Report, a copy of which was sent to you on March 5, 2009.

On March 9, 2009, the Commission received your written response. On March 24, 2009, the Commission received the \$500 civil money penalty payment.
