SUBJECT: Reason To Believe Recommendation – 2020 March Monthly Report for the
Administrative Fine Program

Attached is a list of political committees and their treasurers who failed to file the 2020 March Monthly Report in accordance with 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a). The March Monthly Report was due on March 20, 2020.

The committees listed on the attached RTB Circulation Report either failed to file the report or filed the report no more than thirty (30) days after the due date (considered a late filed report). In accordance with the schedule of civil money penalties for reports at 11 CFR 111.43, these committees should be assessed the civil money penalties highlighted on the attached circulation report.

Recommendation

1. Find reason to believe that the political committees and their treasurers, in their official capacity, listed on the RTB Circulation Report violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and make a preliminary determination that the civil money penalties would be the amounts indicated on the RTB Circulation Report.
2. Send the appropriate letters.

Dear Ms. Dubberly,

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires that your committee file a March Monthly Report of Receipts and Disbursements covering the period February 1, 2020 through February 29, 2020. This report shall be filed no later than March 20, 2020. 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a). Records at the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") indicate that this report was filed on April 17, 2020, 28 days late.

The Act permits the FEC to impose civil money penalties for violations of the reporting requirements of 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a). 52 U.S.C. § 30109g(a)(4). On June 29, 2020, the FEC found that there is reason to believe ("RTB") that Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and you, in your official capacity as treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) by failing to file timely this report on or before March 20, 2020. Based on the FEC's schedules of civil money penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43, the amount of your civil money penalty calculated at the RTB stage is \$236. Please see the attached copy of the Commission's administrative fine regulations at 11 C.F.R. §§ 111.30-111.55. Attachment 1. The Commission's website contains further information about how the administrative fine program works and how the fines are calculated. See <http://www.fec.gov/af/af.shtml>. 11 C.F.R. § 111.34. Your payment of \$236 is due within forty (40) days of the finding, or by August 8, 2020, and is based on these factors:

At this juncture, the following courses of action are available to you:

1. If You Choose to Challenge the RTB Finding and/or Civil Money Penalty

If you should decide to challenge the RTB finding and/or calculated civil money penalty, you must submit a written response to the FEC's Office of Administrative Review. Your response must include the AF# (found at the top of page 1 under your committee's identification number) and be received within forty (40) days of the Commission's RTB finding, or August 10, 2020. 11 CFR § 111.35(a). Your written response must include the reason(s) why you are challenging the RTB finding and/or calculated civil money penalty, and must include the factual basis supporting the reason(s) and supporting documentation. The FEC strongly encourages that documents be submitted in the form of affidavits or declarations. 11 CFR § 111.36(c).

Please note, on June 18, 2020, the Federal Election Commission began the initial phase (Phase I) of its return to normal operations. At this stage, the agency's offices will remain closed to visitors and most of its employees will continue to telework in an effort to limit the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19). The Commission is processing some documents submitted by mail, though processing will not occur on a daily basis until the agency resumes normal mail operations. Nevertheless, a challenge to an RTB finding and/or calculated civil money penalty must be received on time. Thus, all written responses and supporting documentation should be converted to PDF (Portable Document Format) and must be emailed to administrativefines@fec.gov. The Commission encourages the use of electronic signatures on electronically submitted documents, but scanned copies of ink signatures will be accepted. Electronically submitted challenges will be deemed received on the date it is electronically received by staff.

The FEC will only consider challenges that are based on at least one of three grounds: (1) a factual error in the RTB finding; (2) miscalculation of the calculated civil money penalty by the FEC; or (3) your demonstrated use of best efforts to file in a timely manner when prevented from doing so by reasonably unforeseen circumstances that were beyond your control. 11 CFR § 111.35(b). In order for a challenge to be considered on the basis of best efforts, you must have filed the required report no later than 24 hours after the end of these reasonably unforeseen circumstances. *Id.* Examples of circumstances that will be considered reasonably unforeseen and beyond your control include, but are not limited to: (1) a failure of Commission computers or Commission-provided software despite your seeking technical assistance from Commission personnel and resources; (2) a widespread disruption of information transmissions over the Internet that is not caused by a failure of the Commission's or your computer systems or Internet service provider; and (3) severe weather or other disaster-related incident. 11 CFR § 111.35(c). Examples of circumstances that will not be considered reasonably unforeseen and beyond your control include, but are not limited to: (1) negligence; (2) delays caused by vendors or contractors; (3) treasurer and staff illness, inexperience or unavailability; (4) committee computer, software, or Internet

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service provider failures; (5) failure to know filing dates; and (6) failure to use filing software properly. 11 CFR § 111.35(d).

The "failure to raise an argument in a timely fashion during the administrative process shall be deemed a waiver" of your right to present such argument in a petition to the U.S. District Court under 52 U.S.C. § 30109. 11 CFR § 111.38.

If you intend to be represented by counsel, please advise the Office of Administrative Review. You should provide, in writing, the name, address and telephone number of your counsel and authorize counsel to receive notifications and communications relating to this challenge and imposition of the calculated civil money penalty.

2. If You Choose Not to Pay the Civil Money Penalty and Not to Submit a Challenge

If you do not pay the calculated civil money penalty and do not submit a written response, the FEC will assume that the preceding factual allegations are true and make a final determination that Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and you, in your official capacity as treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assess a civil money penalty.

Unpaid civil money penalties assessed through the Administrative Fine regulations will be subject to the Debt Collection Act of 1982 ("DCA"), as amended by the Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996, 31 U.S.C. § 3701 et seq. The FEC may take any and all appropriate action authorized and required by the DCA, as amended, including transfer to the U.S. Department of the Treasury for collection. 11 CFR § 111.51(a)(2).

3. If You Choose to Pay the Civil Money Penalty

If you should decide to pay the calculated civil money penalty, follow the payment instructions on page 4 of this letter. Upon receipt of your payment, the FEC will send you a final determination letter.

NOTICE REGARDING PARTIAL PAYMENTS AND SETTLEMENT OFFERS

4. Partial Payments

If you make a payment in an amount less than the calculated civil money penalty, the amount of your partial payment will be credited towards the full civil money penalty that the Commission assesses upon making a final determination.

5. Settlement Offers

Any offer to settle or compromise a debt owed to the Commission, including a payment in an amount less than the calculated civil money penalty assessed or any

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restrictive endorsements contained on your check or money order or proposed in correspondence transmitted with your check or money order, will be rejected. Acceptance and deposit or cashing of such a restricted payment does not constitute acceptance of the settlement offer. Payments containing restrictive endorsements will be deposited and treated as a partial payment towards the civil money penalty that the Commission assesses upon making a final determination. All unpaid civil money penalty amounts remaining will be subject to the debt collection procedures set forth in Section 2, above.

This matter was generated based on information ascertained by the FEC in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(2). Unless you notify the FEC in writing that you wish the matter to be made public, it will remain confidential in accordance with 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(4)(B) and 30109(a)(12)(A) until it is placed on the public record at the conclusion of this matter in accordance with 11 CFR § 111.42.

As the new treasurer, I misunderstood the difference between quarterly and monthly filing to the FEC. I thought I was supposed to file monthly, due every quarter. If you look at the filings, I filled the Feb 20, Mar 20 and April 20 all on the same day in a group, April 17, 2020 (1st quarter). Then, I filed the second group in the second quarter on July 15, 2020. The second group included the May 20, June 20 and July 20 reports. I used my best efforts in filing as I thought the FEC required. Moving forward, I will submit all reports every month.

On a side note, I would not have been able to file every month in the 2nd quarter due to the Covid-19 crisis. Our offices were closed for three months. That said, this did not affect me as I planned on filing quarterly anyway in July.

**REVIEWING OFFICER RECOMMENDATION
OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW (“OAR”)**

AF# 3783, AF# 3799, and AF# 3844 – Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and Shannon Dubberly, in his official capacity as Treasurer (C00406645)

Summary of Recommendations

Make a final determination in AF# 3783 that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$684.

Make a final determination in AF# 3799 that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$236.

Make a final determination in AF# 3844 that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$684.

Reason-to-Believe Background

The 2020 February Monthly Report was due on February 20, 2020. The Committee filed the report on April 17, 2020, 57 days late. The report is not election sensitive and was not filed within 30 days of the due date; therefore, the report is considered not filed. 11 C.F.R. §§ 111.43(d)(1) and (e)(1). On June 29, 2020, the Commission found reason to believe (“RTB”) that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) for failing to file the 2020 February Monthly Report. The Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$684 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. A letter dated July 14, 2020 was sent to the respondents’ email address of record by the Reports Analysis Division (“RAD”) to notify them of the Commission’s RTB finding and civil money penalty.

The 2020 March Monthly Report was due on March 20, 2020. The Committee filed the report on April 17, 2020, 28 days late. The report is not election sensitive and was filed within 30 days of the due date; therefore, the report is considered late. 11 C.F.R. §§ 111.43(d)(1) and (e)(1). On June 29, 2020, the Commission found RTB that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) for failing to file the 2020 March Monthly Report. The Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$236 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. A letter dated July 10, 2020 was sent to the respondents’ email address of record by RAD to notify them of the Commission’s RTB finding and civil money penalty.

The 2020 May Monthly Report was due on May 20, 2020. The Committee filed the report on July 15, 2020, 56 days late. The report is not election sensitive and was not filed within 30

days of the due date; therefore, the report is considered not filed. 11 C.F.R. §§ 111.43(d)(1) and (e)(1). On June 30, 2020, the Commission found RTB that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) for failing to file the 2020 May Report. The Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$684 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. A letter dated July 14, 2020 was sent to the respondents' email address of record by RAD to notify them of the Commission's RTB finding and civil money penalty.

Legal Requirements

The Federal Election Campaign Act ("Act") states that the treasurer of a political committee not authorized by a candidate which is filing on a monthly basis shall file monthly reports no later than 20 days after the end of the month. 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a)(4)(B) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(c)(3). Reports electronically filed must be received and validated at or before 11:59 pm Eastern Standard/Daylight Time on the filing deadline to be timely filed. 11 C.F.R. §§ 100.19(c) and 104.5(e). The treasurer shall be personally responsible for the timely filing of reports. 11 C.F.R. § 104.14(d).

Respondents' Challenges

On August 7, 2020, the Commission received the written response ("challenge") from the Treasurer for AF# 3783, AF# 3799, and AF# 3844. He states that as the new Treasurer, he misunderstood the monthly and quarterly reporting requirements. He believed that he should "file monthly, due on a quarterly basis." The Treasurer further explains that the Committee filed the 2020 March and April Monthly Reports together on April 17, 2020; and the Committee filed the 2020 May, June, and July Monthly Reports together on July 15, 2020. He states that the Committee will file reports on a monthly basis moving forward.

The Treasurer also notes that the Committee's office was closed for three months due to COVID-19, which would have prevented him from filing on a monthly basis in the second quarter. However, the Treasurer acknowledges the office closures did not impact the filing of these reports because he planned to file these reports in July.

Analysis

The Treasurer states he was new in the position and misunderstood the Committee's filing requirements as a monthly filer. However, Commission records indicate the Commission appropriately notified and reminded the Committee of its monthly reporting requirements on multiple occasions prior to the filing deadlines.

2020 February Monthly Report (AF# 3783)

On January 31, 2020, the Commission's Information Division sent the 2020 February Monthly Report Prior Notice to treasurer@tarrantgop.org and rick@rickbarnespresents.com, the email addresses listed on the Committee's Statement of Organization as of that date. On February 18, 2020, the Commission's Electronic Filing Office ("EFO") sent a reminder email regarding the 2020 February Monthly Report to treasurer@tarrantgop.org, rick@rickbarnespresents.com, and treasurer@tcgop.org. On February 21, 2020, the day following the filing deadline, EFO sent a late

notification email to the same three email addresses because the report had not yet been filed. On March 6, 2020, RAD sent the non-filer notification via email to treasurer@tarrantgop.org and rick@rickbarnespresents.com.

2020 March Monthly Report (AF# 3799)

On February 27, 2020, the Commission's Information Division sent the 2020 March Monthly Report Prior Notice to treasurer@tarrantgop.org and rick@rickbarnespresents.com, the email addresses listed on the Committee's Statement of Organization as of that date. On February 18, 2020, EFO sent a reminder email regarding the 2020 March Monthly Report to treasurer@tarrantgop.org, rick@rickbarnespresents.com, and treasurer@tcgop.org. On March 21, 2020, the day following the filing deadline, EFO sent a late notification email to the same three email addresses because the report had not yet been filed. On April 7, 2020, RAD sent the non-filer notification via email to treasurer@tarrantgop.org and rick@rickbarnespresents.com.

2020 May Monthly Report (AF# 3844)

On April 30, 2020, the Commission's Information Division sent the 2020 May Monthly Report Prior Notice to treasurer@tarrantgop.org and s_dubberly@yahoo.com, the email addresses listed on the Committee's Statement of Organization as of that date.¹ On May 18, 2020, EFO sent a reminder email regarding the 2020 March Monthly Report to treasurer@tarrantgop.org, s_dubberly@yahoo.com, and rick@rickbarnespresents.com. On May 21, 2020, the day following the filing deadline, EFO sent a late notification email to the same three email addresses because the report had not yet been filed. On June 5, 2020, RAD sent the non-filer notification via email to treasurer@tarrantgop.org and s_dubberly@yahoo.com.

Conclusion

The challenge fails to address any of the three valid grounds at 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b). These are: (i) the RTB finding is based on factual errors; and/or (ii) the improper calculation of the civil money penalty; and/or (iii) they used best efforts to file on time but were prevented from doing so by reasonably unforeseen circumstances that were beyond their control and they filed the report no later than 24 hours after the end of these circumstances. 11 C.F.R. § 104.14(d). Moreover, failure to know reporting dates and inexperience of the treasurer are specifically included at 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(d) as examples of a circumstance that will not be considered reasonably unforeseen and beyond the respondents' control. Therefore, the Reviewing Officer recommends that the Commission make a final determination in AF# 3783, AF# 3799, and AF# 3844 that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assess civil money penalties of \$684, \$236, and \$684, respectively.

- (3) Adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for AF# 3799 involving Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and Shannon Dubberly, in his official capacity as Treasurer, in making the final determination;
- (4) Make a final determination in AF# 3799 that Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and Shannon Dubberly, in his official capacity as Treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$236;
- (5) Adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for AF# 3844 involving Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and Shannon Dubberly, in his official capacity as Treasurer, in making the final determination;
- (6) Make a final determination in AF# 3844 that Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and Shannon Dubberly, in his official capacity as Treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$684; and

DECLARATION OF KRISTIN D. ROSER

1. I am the Chief of the Compliance Branch for the Reports Analysis Division of the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”). In my capacity as Chief of the Compliance Branch, I oversee the initial processing of the Administrative Fine Program. Subject: Final Determination Recommendation in AF# 3783, AF# 3799, and AF# 3844 – Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and Shannon Dubberly, in his official capacity as Treasurer (C00406645)

On June 29, 2020, the Commission found reason to believe (“RTB”) that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) for failing to file the 2020 February Monthly Report and made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$684 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43 (AF# 3783). On June 29, 2020, the Commission found RTB that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) for failing to file the 2020 March Monthly Report and made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$236 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43 (AF# 3799). On June 30, 2020, the Commission found RTB that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) for failing to file the 2020 May Report and made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$684 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43 (AF# 3844).

On August 7, 2020, the Commission received their written response (“challenge”). After reviewing the challenge, the Reviewing Officer Recommendation (“ROR”) dated September 28, 2020 was forwarded to the Commission, a copy was forwarded to the respondents, and is hereby incorporated by reference. The Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission make a final determination in AF# 3783, AF# 3799, and AF# 3844 that the respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assess civil money penalties of \$684, \$236, and \$684, respectively.

Within 10 days of transmittal of the recommendation, they may file a written response with the Commission Secretary which may not raise any arguments not raised in their challenge or not directly responsive to the ROR. 11 C.F.R. § 111.36(f). The respondents have since paid the recommended civil money penalties of \$684, \$236, and \$684.

OAR Recommendations

- (1) Adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for AF# 3783 involving Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and Shannon Dubberly, in his official capacity as Treasurer, in making the final determination;
- (2) Make a final determination in AF# 3783 that Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and Shannon Dubberly, in his official capacity as Treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$684;
- (3) Adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for AF# 3799 involving Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and Shannon Dubberly, in his official capacity as Treasurer, in making the final determination;

On June 29, 2020, the Federal Election Commission (“the Commission”) found reason to believe (“RTB”) that Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and you, in your official capacity as Treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) for failing to file the 2020 March Monthly Report. By letter dated July 14, 2020, the Commission sent notification of the RTB finding that included a civil money penalty calculated at RTB of \$236 in accordance with the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. On August 7, 2020, the Office of Administrative Review received your written response challenging the RTB finding.

The Reviewing Officer reviewed the Commission’s RTB finding with its supporting documentation and your written response. Based on this review, the Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission make a final determination that Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and you, in your official capacity as Treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assess a civil money penalty in the amount of \$236 in accordance with 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. The Reviewing Officer Recommendation was sent to you on September 29, 2020.

On February 17, 2021, the Commission adopted the Reviewing Officer’s recommendation and made a final determination that Tarrant County Republican Victory Fund and you, in your official capacity as Treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) and assessed a civil money penalty of \$236. It is based on the same factors used to calculate the civil money penalty at RTB. A copy of the Final Determination Recommendation is attached.

On October 21, 2020, the Commission received your \$236 payment.

If You Choose to Appeal the Final Determination and/or Civil Money Penalty

If you choose to appeal the final determination, you should submit a written petition, within 30 days of receipt of this letter, to the U.S. District Court for the district in which the committee or you reside, or transact business, requesting that the final determination be modified or set aside. See 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(4)(C)(iii). Your failure to raise an argument in a timely

fashion during the administrative process shall be deemed a waiver of the respondents' right to present such argument in a petition to the district court under 52 U.S.C. § 30109. 11 CFR § 111.38.

The confidentiality provisions at 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(12) no longer apply and this matter is now public. Pursuant to 11 C.F.R. §§ 111.42(b) and 111.20(c), the file will be placed on the public record within 30 days from the date of this notification.
