
The Federal Election Commission received a notification from the Small Business Administration (SBA) that FJC Growth Capital Corporation (FJC) made a political contribution in violation of federal election laws. SBA discovered the violation in the course of a routine program examination of FJC, a small business investment company (SBIC) licensed by it under section 301(c) of the Small Business Investment Act of 1958, as amended.

The FEC has reviewed the facts reported by the SBA that pertain to this matter. Before proceeding with the case however, we need to bring to your attention to the existence of the Commission's Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) program.

This matter may be eligible for processing in that program. To be eligible for ADR processing, i.e., negotiation and/or mediation, you must: 1) indicate a willingness to have your case submitted to the ADR process; 2) agree to participate in bilateral negotiations and if necessary mediation; and 3) waive the Statute of Limitations restrictions while the matter is under discussion with the FEC.

If you agree to engage in ADR, the matter will be evaluated on its merits. Additional information about the FEC's ADR program is provided on the enclosed material. If after reviewing the enclosed ADR material, you would like your matter to be considered for possible ADR processing you must indicate that on the enclosed form. A failure to respond will be taken as a notice of disinterest in the program and your case will be dropped from the further consideration for ADR. In that event, your case will be pursued by the Commission's Office of General Counsel. If you have any questions about the ADR program please contact 202-694-1670.
