
Dear Ms. Morrison:

A letter was sent to your office on December 18, 2000, regarding an opportunity to participate in the new Alternative Dispute Resolution ("ADR") program at the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") to resolve a referral from the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD"). The referral to the Office of General Counsel was for further investigation of possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act by District 1199C National Union of Hospital & Health Care Employees Political Action Fund ("Committee").

If the Committee is interested in having this referral resolved through ADR, you must affirmatively respond no later than January 23, 2001, by filing an executed Commitment to Submit Matter to ADR Program and Statement of Designation of Representative/Counsel. In the event you submit these documents via facsimile (202-219-0613), please send the originals via first class mail to this Office.

A lack of response will be considered a disinterest in proceeding in ADR and will result in the referral regarding your Committee being forwarded to the FEC's Office of General Counsel.
