Dear Mr. Brame:

This letter : to advise you of the settlement of the complaint that you filed on October 17, 2000 against the Robert Casey Jr. for Auditor General Committee and two other named respondents charging various violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act")

After receiving replies from the respondents, the Commission evaluated the case and assigned the matter to the Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) Office for processing. Subsequently, that Office entered into negotiations with the respondents' representatives. The purpose of the negotiations was to achieve a satisfactory resolution of the issues involved in the complaint and at the same time promote compliance with the Act. Those negotiations resulted in three negotiated agreements that were approved by the Commission on August 14, 2001. Copies of the negotiated agreements with each of the three Respondents is enclosed.

The entire matter was placed on the public record next month.
