Dear Ms. Miller:

This letter is to advise you of the resolution of the complaint which you filed with the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") on May 3, 2000, against Moran for Congress, James P. Moran and H. Robert Morrison, Treasurer (collectively "respondents"). After receiving a reply from respondents, the Commission evaluated the case and entered into negotiations with counsel for respondents. The purpose of the negotiations was to achieve a satisfactory resolution of the issues involved in the complaint and at the same time promote compliance with the Act. Those negotiations resulted in a negotiated agreement that was approved by the Commission on August 24, 2001. A copy of the agreement is enclosed.

The Commission is obligated by federal statute to put settlement agreements on the public record. 11 C.F.R. § 111.20(b). Accordingly, this agreement and appropriate portions of the file will be forwarded to the Public Information Office to be placed on the public record within thirty days.
