
Dear Mr. Silberman:

We received your letter offering Kennedy for Senate an opportunity to enter into ADR. Our letter to you dated September 21, 2000 on behalf of Kennedy for Senate, set forth our understanding of the facts of Mrs. Bernadette Kearney's contributions to Kennedy for Senate.
