Summary of Case: RAD referred International Brotherhood of Boilermakers Campaign Assistance Fund and William T. Creeden, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on its 2020 August Monthly Report, originally filed on August 18, 2020. On November 25, 2020, the Committee filed an Amended 2020 August Monthly Report including \$159,492.93 in additional receipts.

In Form 99s (Miscellaneous Electronic Submissions) filed on February 19, 2021 and March 4, 2021, the Committee states that their offices were unexpectedly closed and they were unable to collect data necessary to file the report due to the COVID-19 virus. The Respondent states that amendments were filed as soon as they were able to retrieve the data and verify information.
