Summary of Case: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) is referring South Dakota First and Sharon Boysen, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failure to identify the source of a cash-on-hand discrepancy totaling \$34,400.00 disclosed on its 2020 Termination Report, received July 17, 2020.

On September 9, 2020, the Respondent filed an FEC Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) stating that the amount is a discrepancy between the filings and actual bank balance. In addition, the Committee states that they closed their bank account with a balance of zero when they filed their July 17, 2020 Termination Report.
