The Audit Division referred A19-10 for processing on April 6, 2021, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 1006. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

Summary of Case: The Audit Division referred National Tooling & Machining Association (NTMA) Committee for a Strong Economy and Doug Derosé, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for one finding detailed in the Final Audit Report of the Commission, as approved on March 11, 2021. The finding states that the Committee failed to properly disclose the required information for contributions made to federal candidate committees totaling \$52,887.

In response to the audit, the Committee filed amended reports that corrected the disclosure errors. The Committee also stated that it has now hired an accounting firm to prepare and file disclosure reports and that a staff member attended the FEC regional conference in February 2020, to increase their knowledge of campaign finance law and reporting requirements.
