Summary of Case: RAD referred LIUNA Minnesota & North Dakota/Laborers' District Council of Minnesota & North Dakota and Joel A. Smith, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely file one (1) 48-Hour Report totaling \$77,993.14 to support four (4) independent expenditures disclosed on the 2020 12-Day Pre-General Report.

On January 14, 2021, the Committee filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) stating that it inadvertently failed to file the 48-Hour Reports because it was unaware of independent expenditure reporting requirements.
