**Summary of Case:** RAD referred Conservatives Acting Together Political Action Committee (CATPAC) and David Satterfield, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely file one (1) 48-Hour Report totaling \$122,094.32 to support one (1) independent expenditure disclosed on the 2020 12-Day Pre-General Report.

On January 7, 2021, the Committee filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) stating that the 48-Hour Report had been prepared timely but was inadvertently not filed timely.
